Winter is being kind to us so far but I am sure a surprise is coming SOON!



Rocco's Corner





1953 Corvette Sting Ray – "The Birth of America's Sports Car"

Quick Facts

- It was the first production car ever built with a fiberglass body.
- Each Corvette was basically "hand built".
- Chevrolet was not able to get a V-8 engine for its Corvette from Cadillac, Oldsmobile or Pontiac.
- After some modifications to the standard "Blue Flame Special" six cylinder engine, Chevrolet was able to produce a 150 HP engine instead of the regular 115 HP engine.
- Production of the 1953 Corvette began at the Flint, Michigan plant.
- The first 1953 Corvette SN E53F001001 was built on Tuesday June 30, 1953.
- The first 5 Corvettes to roll off the assembly line did not have an outside rear view mirror.
- The first 50 Corvettes were delivered to "handpicked celebrities", athletes and corporate executives.
- Unfortunately Chevrolet found that there weren't 250 more buyers who wanted to pay a high price for a car that had leaks in the windshield and lacked performance.
- It is believed that *only 183* 1953 Corvettes were sold!
- On December 24, 1953 production of the 1953 Corvette was finished at the Flint, Michigan plant.
- On December 28, 1953 production of the Corvette was started at the St. Louis, Missouri plant.







Rocco's Corner

- The last 14 1953 Corvettes were produced at the St. Louis plant.





- Production of the 1953 Corvette ended before January 1, 1954 with a total production of 314 cars.
- Because of the short production run, the 1953 Corvette is the rarest of all the Corvettes.
- All the 1953 Corvettes were painted polo white, had a red interior, black soft top, white wall tires, automatic transmission and 2 spinner hub caps.





- The 1953 Corvettes did not have outside door handles to get in the car you had to reach inside to open the door.
- The base 1953 Corvette cost \$3,498.00!
