## Welcome Voter!

This brochure is a quick guide to many of the elected officials who represent you. You can find ALL the elected officials who represent you at: [myvote.wa.gov](http://myvote.wa.gov).

Enter your name and birthday, click continue. From the left side box click "My districts & elected officials." When you click on a district, the elected officials' names and websites appear. No online access? Call Snohomish County Elections at 425-388-3444.

Now that you know who your representatives are, do you want to tell them about an issue or a concern in your community? Here are some ways to do that.

**GET THEIR CONTACT INFORMATION.** Use a website or phone number. A website will provide a way to contact them by email, their committees, events, and probably their positions on issues. At the local level, the website will let you know when that local board meets and the next agenda.

**MAKE YOUR VOICE HEARD.** These actions have been effective for our League members, and they can work for you.

- 1) **Prepare.** However you contact the elected officials, it is essential to briefly and clearly express what your position is, why it is important to you, and what you want the elected officials to do. Ask them for their support. Your information could include how your position would make current law better, who agrees with your position, and why it is better than that of the opponents.
- 2) **Write, phone or email elected official(s).** Include your full name and address so they know you are a constituent—someone who could vote for them.
- 3) **Meet with your elected officials.** Search the website for meeting times and places of local governments. When you arrive, sign in and indicate by your name that you would like to speak. For State or Federal elected officials, email or call to make an appointment.
- 4) In addition to directly contacting your elected officials, you could **write a letter to the editor** of a local paper. Include your full name, street address, and daytime phone for verification purposes; only your name will be printed. Limit your letter to 250 words and send only one letter per 30-day period. Be timely, brief, civil, and persistent.

Remember to update your voter registration if you move to another address or change your name. Go to [myvote.wa.gov](http://myvote.wa.gov) and click on "Update My Voter Registration."

## Elections & Voting

Voting in Washington State is conducted by mail-in ballot.

To vote, you must be a US citizen, a resident of Washington State for 30 days before the next election, and age 18 on or before Election Day. Snohomish County Elections mails ballots 20 days before any election to the street address of each registered voter. If you do not receive a ballot within 10 days of an election, contact Snohomish County Elections, [snohomishcountywa.gov/224/Elections-Voter-Registration](http://snohomishcountywa.gov/224/Elections-Voter-Registration) or call 425-388-3444.

To register to vote or to see if you are registered at your current address, go to [sos.wa.gov/elections](http://sos.wa.gov/elections) and click on MYVOTE. In order to vote you must be registered at least 29 days before any election. You may register on-line in multiple languages OR you may pick up a registration form at the office of Snohomish County Elections, your public library, or a post office. A first time Washington voter may register in person up to 8 days before an election. Snohomish County Elections is located at 3000 Rockefeller Ave, Everett, 98201.

You do NOT need to declare a political party affiliation to vote.

Ballots may be returned by mail or deposited at secured drop boxes. For drop box locations go to [snohomishcountywa.gov/225/Ballot-Drop-Box-Locations](http://snohomishcountywa.gov/225/Ballot-Drop-Box-Locations).

### Felons and Voting Rights

If you were convicted of a felony in Washington State, your right to vote is restored on your release from prison, unless you are still under the supervision of the DOC (aka: community custody). Once your right is restored, you must re-register to receive a ballot. If you have questions about your status with the DOC, call 800-430-9674.

### Homeless Voters' Rights
