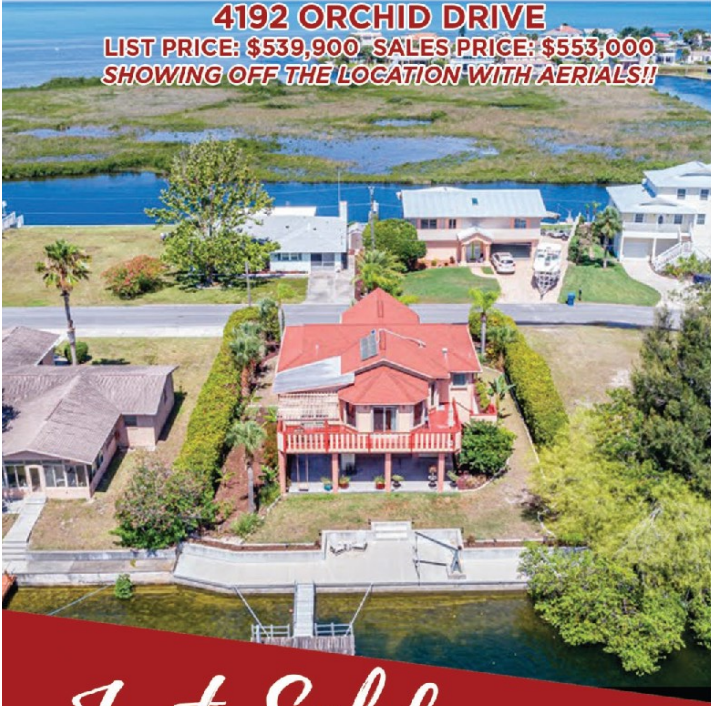


















## REFLECTIONS ON LIFE ON HERNANDO BEACH

If you walk around Hernando Beach you will see new homes being built, homes being renovated and even some homes being torn down. It is somewhat startling to realize how few open lots remain in our community. Hernando Beach is growing just like Hernando County, which is the third fastest growing County in the state. As an interesting aside, if the state of Florida was a separate nation, it would have the seventeenth largest economy in the world.

On a different but related point, have you noticed, based on the recent county tax appraisal records, how much homes have appreciated in value in Hernando Beach?

While walking around the neighborhood, I have been stopped and asked by drivers for directions to the Beach. How have you responded to this question? I usually send people to Pine Island, Jenkin's Creek Park or Linda Pederson Park. Unfortunately, there is no way to send people to the beaches

surrounding the islands in the Weeki Wachee preserve.

My wife and I occasionally walk in the Weeki Wachee preserve. How many times have you recently walked there? The gate to the Weeki Wachee preserve on Osawa Boulevard is only open two Saturday's each month and parking is very limited. The community could have greater access if the gates were open more frequently and if there was more available parking. Additional restroom facilities would also be a plus. Hernando county is currently conducting a feasibility study to see whether it makes sense to build a wooden walkway that would link Linda Pederson Park with the lake area in the Weeki Wachee preserve. Such a walkway would greatly facilitate access to the preserve for all residents of Hernando County.

### CHANGE IN HERNANDO COUNTY

This weekend, friends and I had a chance to visit Beasley Farms located on the east side of Brooksville. Driving from Hernando Beach to Beasley Farms reminded me of the old Florida that I remember as a child. County Roads lined with oak trees decorated with hanging Spanish moss. As your appointed Chairman to the Planning and Zoning Commission I have been contemplating what Hernando County could, or should look like 15 years from now, given the number of zoning and plat applications we as a commission have received since January of this year. For example, we reviewed 17 applications in September and 18 applications in August. Contained in those applications have been hundreds of new homes since January. I as a Floridian realize change is rapidly occurring, managed change can be positive, and given that Hernando County is the third fastest growing county in the state, in a state that is the 16th largest economy in the world, growth will occur.

The question I ask is what should Hernando County look like in 15 years? With growth there are opportunities, but also a greater demand on infrastructure and services. Services such as fire and police protection, ambulance services, utilities, and access to roads and recreational opportunities. In our community of Hernando

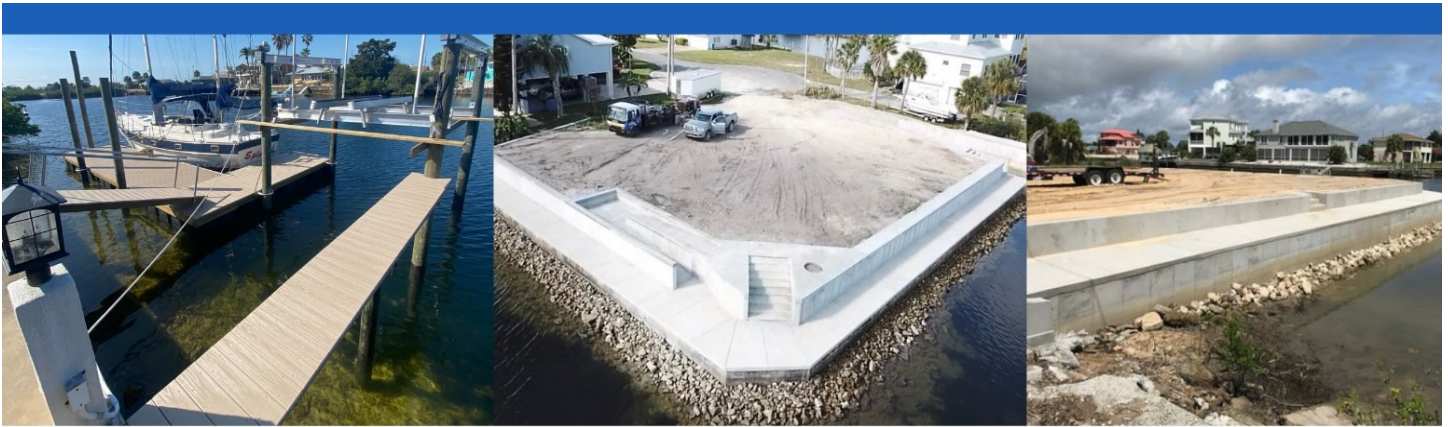

Beach, the great debate concerns the South West Florida Water Management District property that is listed as a preserve and wild life management area. Hernando Beach development started in the mid 1960's. The gate way to Spring Hill Drive was dedicated in 1967. Since April of this year I have interacted with over 2000 residents and business owners and asked the question what bothers you most about Hernando County government. Consistently the response has been access to services, flooding, taxes and concerns about rapid growth. My personal philosophy is not to identify problems, but also to offer possible solutions and recommendations. One possible solution is for the Board of Coun-

ty Commissioners to direct the County Administrator to form an inter departmental team to focus on what Hernando County should look like 15 years from now. I believe the pieces may already exist, such as the comprehensive plan and the roads improvement work plan. The question is have all the plans been integrated and coordinated within County Government? I also recommend workshops be conducted throughout the county to solicit citizens input as to what they would like to see for the future. They "key to the kingdom" though is for residents too actively participate. Hernando County is blessed in the sense that we really are three counties in one. We have a beautiful coastal zone, a city like center in the form of Spring Hill and then a version of old Florida in the form of Brooksville and east.

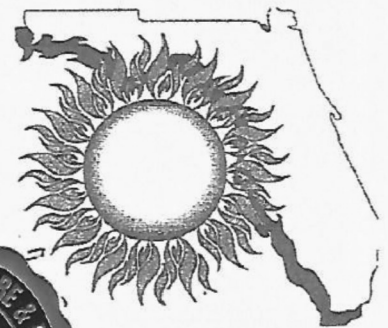
