
CLERGY COLUMN

This coming Thursday is the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary. It is celebrated on the anniversary of the Battle of Lepanto, which was a great naval battle in the Mediterranean, a battle which the Christian navy only could have won through the intercession of the Holy Mother of God. Here is a summary of the Battle of Lepanto from Wikipedia:

In 1571, Pope Pius V organized a coalition of forces from Spain and smaller Christian kingdoms, republics and military orders, to rescue Christian outposts in Cyprus. On October 7, 1571 the Holy League, a coalition of southern European Catholic maritime states, sailed from Sicily and met a powerful Ottoman fleet in the Battle of Lepanto. Knowing that the Christian forces were at a distinct materiel disadvantage Pope Pius V, called for all of Europe to pray the Rosary for victory and led a rosary procession in Rome. After about five hours of fighting, the combined navies of the Papal States, Venice and Spain managed to stop the Ottoman navy. If the Ottomans had won, there was a real possibility that an invasion of Italy could have followed. This victory for the Christians confined Turkish naval power to the eastern Mediterranean. Although the Ottoman Empire was able to build more ships, it never fully recovered from the loss of trained sailors and marines, and was never again the Mediterranean naval power it had been.

Pope Pius V established this feast day as Our Lady of Victory, but subsequent popes have decided to refocus the feast on the praying of the Rosary by calling it the feast of Our Lady of the Rosary. It commemorates the same victory of the Battle of Lepanto, but it also commemorates our undoubted victory by our Lady's intercession every time we pray the Holy Rosary.


