FREEPORT, NY: Nassau County Bar Association gives Long Island Council of Churches \$5,000 grant for its Nassau County emergency food program.

The Long Island Council of Churches (LICC) received a \$5,000 grant from Nassau County Bar Association to support its emergency food program in Nassau County.

We are most grateful to the WE CARE Advisory Board of the Nassau County Bar Association for its generous support. The grant helped us keep up with the increased number of hungry Neighbors we are feeding in our Freeport Emergency Food Center. This allows us to feed more people and give them the food they need. We are feeding nearly 1,500 Neighbors a month in Nassau and giving them enough food for three days.

"We are enduring through a devastating period of financial hardship and we are grateful for the support in **Helping Our Neighbors in Need**," said Freeport Emergency Food Center Coordinator Yolanda Murray.

The Long Island Council of Churches, the region's largest ecumenical and interfaith organization, is a faith-based, non-profit emergency food and social service agency. For 49 years the LICC has brought together hundreds of faith communities to respond rapidly to the emergency needs of the least fortunate. The agency collaborates with more than 50 public and private health and social service agencies to provide emergency food and essential social services to Long Islanders in crisis. In 2017 the LICC fed 30,949 hungry Long Islanders 257,000 meals.
