Aim: How did imperialism affect Southeast Asia and the Pacific Islands?

I. Dutch and British Colonies

- 1. Dutch controlled Indonesia in the 1600s
- 2. Indonesia provided oil, tin and rubber
- 3. The Dutch dominated this area, renaming it the Dutch East Indies
- 4. Dutch set up trading posts and plantations
- 5. Britain acquired Singapore, Malaysia and Burma
- 6. These areas were rich in tin, rubber and teak

II. French Indochina

- 1. Controlled by France since the 19th century
- 2. Rubber and rice became major exports for Indochina
- 3. France was creating a major problem with the Vietnamese people

III. United States

- 1. Won the Spanish-American War the US acquired Puerto Rico, Guam and the Philippines
- 2. Filipinos declared their independence
- 3. The US defeated this uprising promising to teach self-rule
- 4. US helped improve healthcare and education
- 5. But also built large plantations
- 6. The US set up plantations in Hawaii as well
- 7. 1898 Hawaii was annexed to the US
