Neighborhood Review Round-up

On the afternoon of June 8th, the annual neighborhood review was conducted. Overall, residents are to be applauded – homes and properties are looking great! Thank you all for your efforts to keep the neighborhood an appealing place to live. Home sale prices are soaring with recent pending contracts well over the \$600,000 benchmark.

The review was performed by two members of the board, two ARC members, and the property manager. The few noted transgressions were of two categories, natural or maintenance. Low overhanging limbs or shrubbery impeding the sidewalk, and excessive mold or mildew growth on siding was frequently observed. Most occurring maintenance items viewed were build-up of trash and building materials, missing or damaged siding and shutter disrepair.

The Architectural Review Committee meets in the clubhouse on the second Monday of the month. They welcome any homeowners with questions or comments to attend.

Swimming Pool Etiquette Reminders

We are thankful the pool is open. Families have a great place to spend their day, whether it is to escape the heat or have a place for the kids to play. Below are some friendly reminders on etiquette while at the swimming pool.

- 1. <u>Lifeguards:</u> The pool rules request that all members and guests obey the lifeguards. Moreover, please be respectful of the lifeguards. This particularly pertains to children. Members may be asked to get out of the pool if lifeguard instructions are not followed. Further infractions may result in members being asked to depart the swimming pool.
- 2. Wristbands: All children 10 and under must pass the 'basic swimming test' and wear a wristband if they swim in the deep water. Children 10 and under who pass the test and desire to swim in the deep water during any visit to the swimming pool must request a wristband from the lifeguards. Lifeguards may ask children who do not have a wristband and are not under the supervision of their parent(s) to depart the deep end. This rule also pertains to SWIM TEAM MEMBERS 10 and under as they too must wear a wristband if they desire to be in the deep end.
- 3. <u>Eating:</u> All members and their guests are reminded to eat in the fenced-in picnic area only. This includes no eating at any of the tables located on the pool deck. This will reduce the amount of food remnants and trash left throughout the deck as well as keep us in compliance with Fairfax County rules.
- 4. <u>Trash</u>: All members and their guests need to clean up after themselves. This includes placing any trash generated in the trash bins located in the picnic area or near the lifeguard station. Pizza boxes should not be placed in the recycle bins as they have food residue on them and do not qualify as a paper recyclable item.
- 5. <u>Lap Swim:</u> When lifeguards 'whistle' for lap swim at 15 min before each hour, swimmers must exit the pool unless they are lap swimming. Lap swimming is defined as organized swimming up and down the length of the lane

repeatedly. Members can place their feet in the water while sitting on the pool edge during that time. This includes sitting on the pool edge along the new pool stairs; however, members are asked to not sit on the first step in the pool.

- 6. <u>Lifeguard Thru-Way:</u> There is an "outlined blue zone" that leads from the lifeguard office to the pool. Members are asked to not place any personal belongings, deck furniture, etc. in this area. This will allow for direct unobstructed access to the pool, especially in the case of an emergency.
- 7. <u>Lifeguard Pass-By:</u> There is another "outlined blue zone" by the lifeguard stand on the parking lot side of the pool which should be kept clear so patrons can pass behind the lifeguard stand more easily because the deck is so narrow on that side of the pool.
