Jeff Mitchell spoke about the school in Alexandria when the new elementary is completed what does the community want to see done with it. He is on the committee to save the Alexandria School but with COVID they haven't been able to have meetings and things have been on hold, but has a survey that he would like to circulate to the community for opinions and said they do need more community involvement.

Tom Frederick gave the September zoning report.

Tom and trustees discussed South West Licking water and sewer and the upcoming meeting on Friday with them.

Mike Theisen gave the September Fire and EMS reports.

Mike said as of September 2nd all police and fire payroll is eligible to be used for the Corona Virus Relief Fund.

#37-2020 Jean Morrison made a resolution that the funds received for the Corona Virus relief fund will be spent on payroll for the fire department.

2nd by Randal Almendinger. Roll call: Jean Morrison-yes, Bruce Lane –yes, Randal Almendinger –yes. Resolution passed.

The new medic has arrived.

Bruce Lane made a motion that Jean Morrison be the authorized person to sign the title when the old squad is sold.

2nd by Randal Almendinger. Roll call: Jean Morrison – abstain, Bruce Lane –yes, Randal Almendinger –yes. Motion carried.

Mike Theisen and trustees discussed the Santa Brunch, at this time they are unsure if it will happen or not.

Bruce Lane gave an update on the new township building. The electrician will start putting up lights tomorrow, Bruce is working with architects on revisions to the plans, and Bruce has put grass seed down.

Bruce Lane said they had a request from a resident, Mrs. Duris to quit mowing milk weed along road ditches as it is a butterfly habitat.

Randal Almendinger said he got an estimate for the repair of the ramp at the firestation from Country Side Services for \$22,900.00. Randy will get more quotes.

Trustees talked about the Heisey Hills cleanup, still unsure what to do with it.

Randy said township resident Mr. Luikart on 310 would like to have water to his property.

Checks were signed.
