Day Three:

- Today is the day we go to the Great Barrier Reef! After breakfast, we head to Port Douglas where we will board the vessel from Marina Mirage.  <u>Scenic Train through the Rainforest</u>, back to Cairns.
- We then return to the hotel to freshen up, and walk to our group Farewell Dinner at the
 <u>Rydges Fire & Ice Seafood Restaurant</u> to celebrate our tour. The rest of the evening is
 free.
