

# **EDWARD A. GRIGLAK**

**1913 - 1988**

Edward A. Griglak, age 74, of Cleveland, Ok., formerly of Caseville, passed away Friday, April 15 at his home following a long illness.

He was born Oct. 6, 1913 in Chicago, son of the late Thomas and Anne (Wolfe) Griglak. He was united in marriage to Bonnie Ruth LaBarre on Nov. 13, 1943 in Pauls Valley, Ok. The couple moved to Michigan after his discharge from the service in 1946.

He was manager of Sleeper State Park for 27 years, retiring in 1973. They moved to Ok. in 1975. He was a World War II Army veteran and past commander and adjutant of the Jean Post #543 American Legion, Caseville.

Surviving him are his wife, Ruth; one daughter, Mrs. Butch (Marlene) Mankins, both of Cleveland, Ok.; two grandchildren; two sisters, Mrs. Frances Paperd and Mrs. Helen Downer, both of Detroit.

Two sons, Charles and Mark, preceded him in death.

A Funeral Mass was conducted Tuesday, April 19 at 11 a.m. at St. Roch Catholic Church, Caseville. Rev. Fr. Theodore LaMarre officiated with burial in the church cemetery.
