What's Happening—

Kayak Launch & Storage Rack— After months of discussions, research, and planning, a floating dock for launching kayaks, canoes and paddle boards will be installed in boat slip #8 come January. A storage rack for these crafts will be provided to residents on a rental basis. The fee will be \$150 a year. The rack will be located at the far south end of the property by the seawall.

There are currently 12 residents on the waiting list for kayak storage and one rack holds 6—8 crafts. This may be a great time for neighbors to come together to purchase and share a kayak, canoe, or paddleboard instead of owning one themselves.

If you wish to rent space on the rack, notify the office (if you haven't already). Once a space is rented, you will have 30 days to purchase your craft and begin using the rack.

Shutter Removal—the building owns 5 clam shells on the building. Since these are very difficult to maintain, they are being removed and impact windows are being installed. If you have any interest or need in having your shutters removed or painted, please let the office know. The more residents that tag onto this project, the less expensive it will be for all who join in.

For anyone interested in impact windows for their units, the average price for a one bedroom is approximately \$6,500. that includes the sliding glass door and two windows in the bedroom. Again, if a number of residents were interested in upgrading to impact windows, we could work together to obtain better pricing for everyone.

Work Station—A computer and printer will be setup in the Social Room for residents to use. This is being provided as a convenience and should only be used for short tasks and small printing jobs (boarding pass, 2 page documents, etc.). Excessive use of or abuse of the equipment may cause the Board to re-evaluate the situation and possibly remove the equipment all together.

Reminder—please use the new walkway located between the Social Room and Fitness Room to enter and exit the pool area.
