We are excited to announce our upcoming Auditions for the 2023-2024 Season! If you love to dance and perform, we would love to see you at our auditions! Please read through all the info carefully, and feel free to email us with any questions you may have. SODC Elite Company requires talent, commitment, dedication, passion, hard work, an eagerness to learn, and a desire to perform and grow as a dancer. And what your child will gain from the experience is priceless – as both a dancer and an individual.

The audition and selection process requires much planning and thought. Your dancer should be very confident about their desire to be a part of our Company. If your dancer decides to not participate after being selected, it is unfair to all involved. Please talk to your dancer about commitment and how important it is to follow through. We are looking for dancers who are talented, focused, driven, and excited to be part of a well-respected and award-winning dance company.



WHAT TO EXPECT

There are multiple parts to the audition.

The first hour (Ages 4-8) or the first night (Ages 9-18), they will warm-up, perform a barre exercise, followed by learning combos in different genres. The second hour (Ages 4-8) or the second night (ages 9-18), they will complete the skills check and perform the combos learned in small groups.

WHAT TO WEAR

ATTIRE:

Black leotard, black sports bra, black dance shorts, tights optional.

Boys- black shorts and a plain black t-shirt.

HAIR:

Hair in a bun, high or low (this way when you are turning, you will not have any impairments, no messing with your hair).

FACE:

Makeup is optional, clean face

SHOES:

Proper shoes for each subject.



REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Dance needs to be a priority, it is an important part of being a sum and manner of the second sec
- 2. Weekly dance classes Each team has required classes, punctuality is very important.
- 3. Extra rehearsals (most will be on a Friday or Saturday). Team members will receive a list of all extra rehearsal dates as soon as they are determined. Remember, to be the best dancers possible, we must be dedicated. As a result, only illness (not to be be excessive), school activities (i.e. games or concerts) or death in the family are exceptions for missing rehearsal. Choreography will be done in choreography camp separate from regular classes.
- 4. MUST attend ALL competitions and performances in which your TEAM participates to avoid reblocking fees. Reblocking fees are \$100 per dance that you will not be participating in. Comp fees are nonrefundable.
- 5. Normally dance company members will compete in 3 to 4 regional dance competitions and 1 national event. All members are required to participate in recital. There will be other performances scheduled; but we will try to give plenty of advance notice before these performances.
- 6. Summer classes are required beyond Nationals rehearsals. 8 & Under must complete 15 hours of Summer Classes; 9 & Up must complete 20 hours of Summer Classes. This is includes classes/drop ins or private lessons. These will be logged. Dancers can have tremendous growth in the summer!

EXPENSES

- 1. Audition Fee \$20
- 2. Team Fee \$50 All company members will be required to pay a \$50 company fee to cover the costs of extra rehearsals and events for the team.
- 3. Competition Fees Group Dances \$60 per dancer per dance. Duets/Trios range \$70-\$85 per dancer. Solos range \$120-\$160. *These fees are per competition. Nationals fees are slightly higher.
- 4. Convention Fees \$100-200 per Convention, Juniors/PreTeens/Teens/Seniors mandatory
- 5. Workshop Fees \$25, Drop Ins \$10
- 6. Costume Fees Micros/Petites/Minis \$70, Juniors/PreTeens/Teens/Seniors \$80 each per dance
- 7. Costume Accessories Earrings \$10.00, Choker \$20.00 (if needed), Tights \$10.00
- 8. Company T-shirts \$15
- 9. Company Jacket \$75-100
- 10. Choreo Camp Fee \$50 per dance (in August)
- 11. Annual Registration Fee \$25 per dancer per year (not to exceed \$50 per family)
- 12. Summer dance
- 13. Fall season classes Micro/Petites 1.5-2.5 hours \$67-88/mo., Upper Co minimum of 3 hours \$96+/mo.
- 14. Additional fees may apply for other items.
