Dear Allegro Community,

We want to keep you up to date on our ongoing facilities search. The Diocese of Charleston has decided to list for sale the property at 119 Broad Street that Allegro has been using. After careful consideration the Board of Allegro has decided that it is not economically viable for us to pursue purchasing this space. We have identified a suitable building on our block to use as overflow space and we are currently in negotiations to lease that space for the next two school years. Today, the State Office of School Facilities will be on site to confirm that this space will be approved for our occupancy. Allegro continues to negotiate with a potential future permanent location partner, and we hope to be able to update you with good news on that front in the coming weeks.
