<p>PROPOSAL Y-7 - Middle School State Placers Ineligible for Youth State Tournament</p> <p>Option 1 – (Current Format) Top 4 placers excluded from youth state tournament Option 2 – Top 6 placers excluded from youth state tournament.</p>	<p>CIRCLE CHOICE</p> <p>Option 1 - 4 Option 2 - 21 OPTION 2 PASSED</p>

PROPOSAL Y-8 - Youth Headgear Rule	CIRCLE CHOICE
Option 1 – (Current) – Headgear must be worn at youth post season events, wrestler will forfeit matches if no head gear is worn	Option 1 - 25
Option 2 - No headgear required for youth to wrestle in KSWA events.	Option 2 - 3
Clarification - Passing of Option 1 will now require that all wrestlers with long hair will have to wear an approved covering of the hair that must be attached to the head gear per NFHS Rules.	OPTION 1 PASSED

PROPOSAL Y-9 - Youth Uniform Rule	CIRCLE CHOICE
Option 1 – Singlet only, no shorts/Tshirt allowed, failure to comply will result in removal from event	Option 1 - 9

PROPOSAL Y-9A - Violations of Uniform Rule	CIRCLE CHOICE
If Y-9 Option 2 passes - and a uniform violation is deemed present by officials: Injury time will start and wrestler will have that time to change into approved uniform. If wrestler does not return to the mat with approved uniform before injury time is expired, wrestler will forfeit match.	

PROPOSAL Y-10 Youth Weigh in process for Youth State	CIRCLE CHOICE
Option 1 – (Current)- Each Region Host will be required to verify the following: a. Each Wrestlers birth certificate to confirm birth year b. Each wrestlers USA Card c. Each wrestlers weight via youth weigh in (using at least one certified official) d. Send wrestler name, team, birth year and weight to KSWA for entry into the Youth State Tournament Brackets by the following Monday evening of the Youth Regional Event.	Option 1 - 9
	Option 2 - 16
	OPTION 2 PASSED
Option 2 – KSWA will hold a Youth Weigh in the Friday/Saturday before the youth State Tournament at a location to be determined by the KSWA. All wrestlers must weigh in at one of these weigh ins BEFORE the youth state tournament. Failure to weigh in will result in removal from the tournament. KSWA will define the parameters of the weigh in 30 days prior to the youth state tournament. Birth Certificate, USA Card will be required at weigh in.	
Clarification - Any youth wrestlers that participate in the Middle School State Tournament, that weigh in and skin check will count as the official youth weigh in. Birth Certificate and USA Card will be checked at that time.

PROPOSAL MS-12 Paying of Middle School State Tournament Table Workers	CIRCLE CHOICE
Option 1 – (Current) – (No payout) Each region is required to cover their designated table for the event for the entire day. Regional Tournament host to organize worker list and times and make sure their table is covered. Region 1 – Table 1, Region 2 – Table 2, Region 3 – Table 3, Region 4 – Table 4 Tables 5-8 to be covered by the all teams and KSWA as needed.	Option 1 - 22

Option 2 – (If financial possible) - Each region is required to cover their designated table for the event for the entire day. Regional Tournament host to organize worker list and times and make sure their table is covered Region 1 - Table 1, Region 2 – Table 2, Region 3 – Table 3, Region 4 – Table 4. Table workers will be recorded (by team) similar to youth state and earn points. Tables 5-8 to be filled by other teams as needed or by paying workers to work the table for the entire day. At the following spring meeting, members will vote on Middle School State Payouts.	

PROPOSAL MS-13 Post Season Events on Track Wrestling	CIRCLE CHOICE
Option 1 – Teams will be required to host District/Region tournaments on track wrestling. (not the live version with mat side scoring)	Option 1 - 20
