MEDICAL DEPARTMENT

The Medical Department is comprised of Medical and Osteopathic Physicians, Physician Assistants, Nurse Practitioners, Registered Nurses and Medical Assistants. We offer a full spectrum of family health care from newborns to the elderly. We offer complete men's and women's health care including family planning, prenatal care, immunizations, sports physicals and pediatric care.

PROMPT CARE

Prompt care is available Monday thru Friday to provide care for those everyday bumps and bruises or minor emergencies. We provide same day appointments with a minimal wait time.

BEHAVIORAL HEALTH

The Behavioral Health Department provides counseling for children and adults addressing a variety of areas including depression, anxiety, anger, stress, marital problems and substance abuse referral.
