## **2021 Scholarship Application**

**Purpose:** To provide students that have given back to the community a scholarship for higher education. **The emphasis for this scholarship is community service in and around the City of Farmington.**

**Award Components:** Scholarships will be awarded starting at \$500 up to \$2,000.

### **Eligibility Requirements:**

- Applicant must be a citizen of the United States of America residing in Dakota County, MN
- Minimum G.P.A. of 2.8 from last year of school – High School or College

### **Application Process:**

**\*\*\* All applications must contain all the following information and be submitted in a PDF or word format.**

1. **(Page 1)** Help us get to know you. Provide an essay explaining what you have done to help improve your community and a little information about what is important to you.
2. **(Page 2)** Resume including the following information:
  - Full name, date of birth, address, phone number, email address
  - If under 18 years old – Name, address, and phone number of parent(s) or legal guardian(s)
  - List the names of any colleges attended
  - List any community service you have done
  - List any extracurricular activities
  - List any work experience (If over 25, you only need to list current employment)
  - (2) Professional References: Name, Phone #, Email
3. **(Page 3)** Transcripts (unofficial accepted) from your last grade completed that show G.P.A.
  - If you graduated High School or College more than 4 years ago no transcripts are required (copy of Diploma / GED or College Degree is required).
4. **(Page 4)** Attending University Information
  - College Name and address
  - Proof of acceptance or current student enrollment from the above school is required
  - What academic year of college will you be entering, i.e. Freshman, Sophomore
  - Intended Major
  - Will you be attending as a part time or full time student
  - What is the cost per credit
5. **(Page 5)** If you are granted a Scholarship we will need the following payment information:  
*This information needs to be submitted with your scholarship application*  
**\*\*\*\*\* You need to check with the College for this information – they are very specific for payment**
  - Name of Institution that should be written on the check
  - Address that the check should be mailed to
  - Student Id #

# ***Application Deadline is May 1, 2021***

Applications emailed after this date **will not** be considered

All applicants will receive an Email by *July 1<sup>st</sup>* indicating whether a scholarship has been granted.

All scholarship checks will be written and mailed out during the 1<sup>st</sup> week of August, unless you notify the Relief Association of a later date. No checks will be sent before August 1<sup>st</sup> and all checks need to be mailed by December 20, 2021. If scholarship is not claimed by December 20, 2021 it will be forfeited.
