BULLDOZER BURGLARY AT JEWELRY EXCHANGE

February 9, 2013; approx. 5:00 AM

Springfield, NJ

As the snow was falling heavily in the recent storm, someone drove a stolen bulldozer up to a jewelry exchange in Springfield, NJ, smashed through the wall and removed a safe containing approximately \$1 million in jewelry. The safe was lifted onto a flatbed truck and was driven off.

Reports indicate that the camera system may not have been functioning at the time of the burglary.

Recommendations:

1. Periodically check that all cameras and alarm devices are properly functioning.
2. Create back-ups of your records in case they are destroyed.
