Go to [Medicare.gov/plan-compare](https://www.medicare.gov/plan-compare) to find and compare plans that meet your needs.

Open Enrollment begins October 15. This is the time when everyone with Medicare can make changes to their health and drug plans for the upcoming year. December 7 is the last day to make changes to your health and drug plan for 2023. Coverage, with any changes you make, will begin January 1.

If you have questions about how open enrollment will affect you, or how to save money, we will be having at least one informational meeting at the post during the month of September. The meeting will be facilitated by licensed Medicare Brokers and should have valuable information for all. Check the September newsletter for dates & times.
