Judging will be on the Danish system with all exhibits judged on its own merit. Ribbon point value is as follows Blue – 12 pts., Red 10 pts., and White – 8 pts. No points for Grand Champion and Reserve Champion.

The Fulton County Fair will except a limited number of Open Rabbit Exhibits this year. The Open Rabbit Show is open to adult Fulton County exhibitors as well as out-of-County exhibitors.
