Westby Family emigrated to the USA in 1817: About 35 years ago I spoke to an American couple who were looking around our cemetery inspecting the gravestones. After introductions it transpired that the couple, Pat and Peggy Luby were from Madison, Wisconsin, USA. They were looking for the graves of their Bennet or Cowban ancestors. Pat told me that his great, great, grandfather, Robert Bennet and his wife Cecelia (nee Cowban) had emigrated from Westby in 1817 with their 6 children, which included six-week-old George Bennet who was Pat's great grandfather.

The Bennet family were recorded as long ago as 1580 as being recusants (catholics) in Westby. The Bennet family settled in the USA, becoming farmers. Pat Luby was raised on a farm and became a successful agricultural economist. Our contact has been maintained over the intervening years. Sadly, we heard last week that Pat has died, aged 89, which marks a break in the catholic Westby tradition. We continue to pray for Pat and his family at this time. (Yvonne Stewart)
