You will see the red metal building from the road. Be sure to take the driveway (2nd one) across from mailbox marked 940.

From Atlanta, take I 75 South to exit 198 (High Falls Rd.) turn left and go 2.7 miles (you will cross High Falls State Park Bridge) Turn right on Blount Rd.
