While it is good to be engaged in what is going on in the world, especially if it leads us to prayer and aid for those in need, let us not let the narratives of the day drown out the truth of the way we are to live. Let us also not let it drown out the reality of God, God's love, God's truth, God's forgiveness, and God's Kingdom which is for all who love and serve Him and work to bring others to Him. Let us never forget to be people of the way of Christ, no matter what the environment may be, or what group we consider ourselves in.
