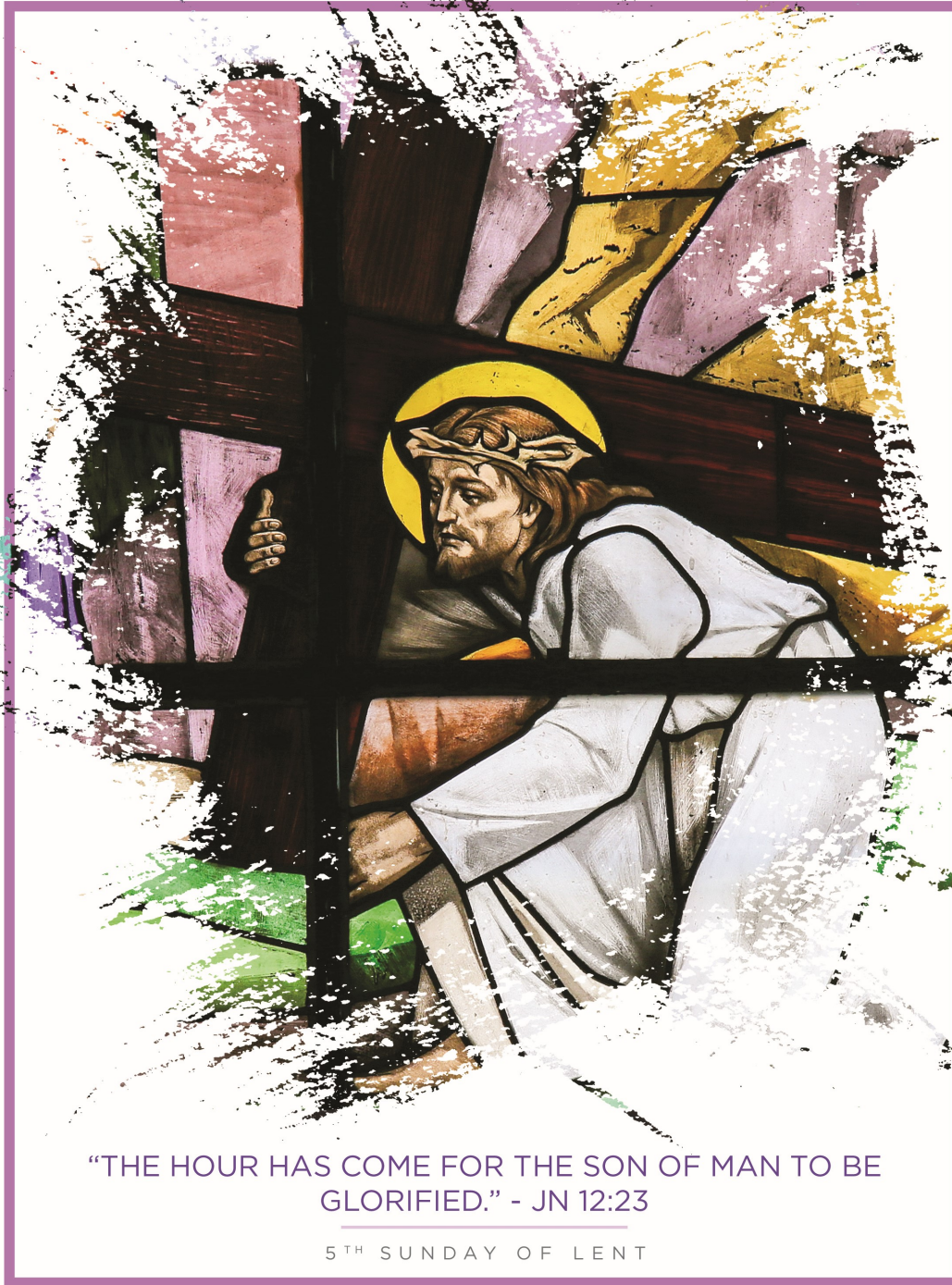

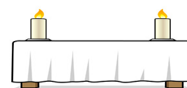

5th Week of Lent

We are drawing ever closer to Holy Week and the Triduum. This week try to say the rosary at least once. Reflect over each of the mysteries deeply while you pray. If you choose, say the Sorrowful Mysteries each time as a way to reflect and take part in the suffering of Christ during these final weeks of Lent.

On the Lenten Resource table you can find new resources all about Holy week, the Triduum, and Easter for you to take home and use.

Palm Sunday

Next Sunday is Palm Sunday. The celebration will look a little different this year, but it will still be a special time. When you get home with your palm, do a quick google search to learn how to fold the palm into crosses – this will be a fun activity for older children!

Families in Faith

This week our 1st Communion class learned about *remembering*. During the Mass we remember that Jesus is the greatest gift we can receive. The children learned about the Last Supper and how Jesus told us to *do this in memory of me*. They learned how we do this at the Mass with the Liturgy of the Eucharist.

Continue to use the flash cards given out previously to help your child learn about the different objects in the church. Encourage them to be engaged by being engaged yourself, and ask them questions about the Mass afterwards. Through everyday actions and conversations you as the domestic church are able to teach and pass on the faith to your child, do not be discouraged!

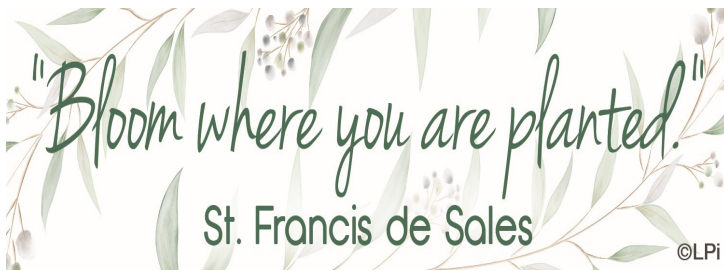
