Easton Wings of Hope presents “Hidden in Plain Sight” at NRT Festival

Easton, Massachusetts, October 2, 2016:

At this year’s NRT Harvest Festival and Craft Fair, Easton Wings of Hope was on hand to provide an educational and eye-opening experience for parents relating to teen substance use. Set up at the Fair was an interactive program called ***Hidden in Plain Sight***. This program provides parents an opportunity to walk through a mock teen bedroom—contained in that bedroom are otherwise ordinary items that may alert parents to risky behavior by their children. The interactive program, made possible by a generous donation from the Easton Charitable Trust, was well received by members of the community. A steady stream of adults walked through the display during the day, asked excellent questions of EWOH volunteers, and left more enlightened and aware of the risks affecting our children today.
