I cannot pray "FOREVER AND EVER" if I am too anxious about each day's affairs.

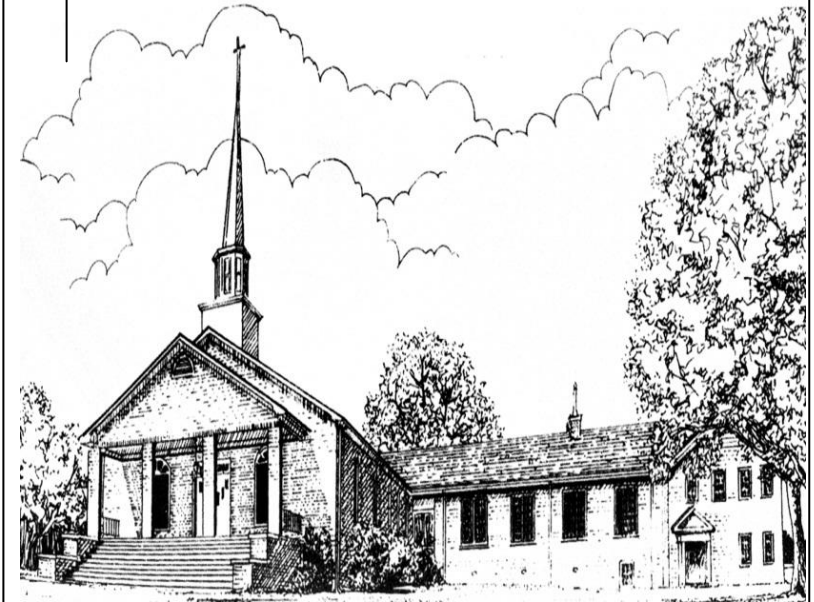
I cannot pray "AMEN" unless I honestly say "Not MY will, but THY will be done." So let it be.
