ROCCO'S CORNER March, 2017



Did you know that:

- not all models of the Chevrolet Corvette are referred to as "Sting Ray" or "Stingray"
- the C2 Corvette "Sting Ray" was first introduced in 1963
- the nameplate "Sting Ray" was used on the C2 Corvettes until 1967
- the nameplate "Sting Ray" was not used on the 1968 Corvette but Chevrolet still referred to the 1968 model as a "Sting Ray"
- in 1969 Chevrolet changed the nameplate on the Corvette
- the 1969 nameplate on the Corvette was changed from the 2-word "Sting Ray" to the 1-word "Stingray"
- the one-word nameplate "Stingray" was used on the C3 Corvettes until 1976







• the "Stingray" lettering was removed from the Corvettes in 1977

• the C7 (2014) Chevrolet Corvette was the first Corvette to bear the name "Stingray" name since the C3 1976 model









NOTE: in my February 2017 Rocco's Corner, I used the heading "1953 Corvette Sting Ray – The Birth of America's Sports Car".
