A Note From Rick: Markets were stronger across the board at TLA on Tuesday. Fresh cows and springers sold better Tuesday than they have on previous Tuesdays, but not as strong as the bigger groups of cattle sold in the special springer sale. The bull calf market bounced back sharply also this week. The bigger, better half of the calves brought from \$.85 to \$1.20. Slaughter cows were \$3 to \$4 stronger this week. Bulls and fat cattle were a bit stronger as well. The hay market was the one exception to stronger markets. We didn't have a lot of really prime hay but the grass hay and coarser hay was definitely a little weaker in price. The building project continues to progress nicely and it's great to see the end in sight. Looking forward to the Driving Horse Auction this Saturday to kick off the Fall schedule.
