


UNISON SCRIPTURE READING

From being satisfied with things as they are, in the church or the world, from failing to share your indignation about injustice; O God, deliver us.


From selfishness, self-indulgence, or self-pity, O God, deliver us.

We pray in the mighty and holy name of the Lord Jesus Christ. Amen.







Take, drink it all.




