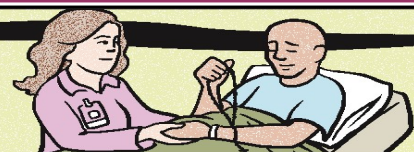

## † SAINTS OF THE WEEK †

**Aug. 7—St. Sixtus II and Companions** – Forbidden to hold services, he and his deacons continued to worship in the chapel in the cemetery of Prêtextatus.

**St. Cajetan**– An Italian Catholic priest and religious reformer, who helped found the Theatines.

**Aug. 8—St. Dominic**– Also known as Dominic of Osma and Dominic of Caleruega, often called Dominic de Guzmán and Domingo Félix de Guzmán, was a Castilian priest and founder of the Dominican Order. Dominic is the patron saint of astronomers.

**Aug. 9—St. Teresa Benedicta of the Cross**—A German Jewish philosopher who converted to Roman Catholicism and became a Discalced Carmelite nun.

**Aug. 10—St. Lawrence**—One of the seven deacons of the city of Rome, Italy under Pope St. Sixtus II who were martyred in the persecution of the Christians that the Roman Emperor Valerian ordered in 258.

**Aug. 11—St. Clare**—An Italian saint and one of the first followers of Saint Francis of Assisi.

**Aug. 12—St. Jane Frances de Chantal**—A Roman Catholic saint, who founded a religious order after the death of her husband.

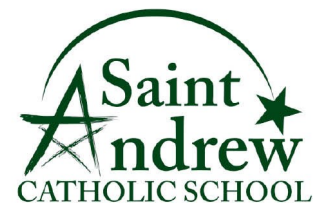

## **Charismatic Renewal Golden Jubilee Celebration**

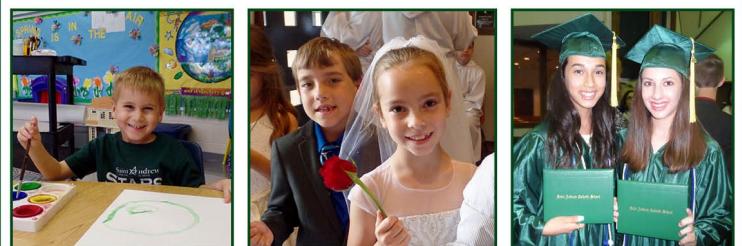

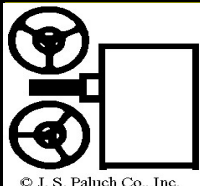

# SU ROSTRO SE PUSO RESPLANDECIENTE COMO EL SOL

## 6 de agosto de 2017 • La Transfiguración del Señor

El Evangelio de san Mateo revela que el rostro de Jesús “brillaba como el sol” durante su transfiguración. El evangelista está usando una figura de discurso, desde luego, pero podemos imaginar lo qué fue observar la Transfiguración pudo haber sido para Pedro, Santiago y Juan. La brillante del rostro de Jesús se compara con la del sol. El planeta Tierra está a una distancia del sol de noventa y tres millones de millas, aun así, si miramos al sol directamente sufrimos quemaduras en nuestras retinas, o un daño permanente en los ojos o pérdida severa de la vista. Los discípulos estaban tan cerca a Jesús durante la Transfiguración que él podía tocarlos. ¿Cómo es ser testigo de la brillantes de Jesús? Los discípulos estaban atemorizados. Quizá ver a Jesús en su gloria se percibe como peligroso como cuando empieza un eclipse solar. Sin lugar a dudas, los discípulos taparon sus ojos, cayendo a tierra cubriéndose sus caras.

### LA MISERICORDIA DE DIOS

Aunque la experiencia de los discípulos en la montaña fue amedrentadora, nuestro Señor misericordioso no quiere que el miedo ensombrezca el milagro del que ellos fueron testigos. Jesús los tocó, diciéndoles: “levántense, no tengan

miedo”. Las palabras de Dios que provenían de la nube fueron igual de alentadoras: “Este es mi Hijo amado en quien me complazco, escúchenlo”. Dios amorosamente nos tranquiliza, confirmando la identidad de Jesús como el Hijo del Hombre e invitándonos a poner atención a aquel que viene a salvarnos.

San Pedro, un testigo de este evento declara que su testimonio es “totalmente confiable”. Podemos depender de su palabra. San Pedro espera que sus palabras sean como una “lámpara brillante en un lugar oscuro, hasta que el alba del día y la estrella de la mañana empiece a levantarse en nuestros corazones”. Gracias a Dios, podemos confiar en las experiencias transformadoras de vida de las demás personas que nos ayudan a transformar nuestra propia vida. Quizá no tengamos una experiencia tan extrema en lo alto de una montaña como la que tuvieron Pedro, Santiago y Juan; por lo que los escuchamos a ellos como testigos de la majestad de Dios. Todas las lecturas de hoy nos recuerdan que Dios nos da la Palabra para creer y vivir y nos envía las palabras de Daniel, Pedro y Mateo para animarnos.

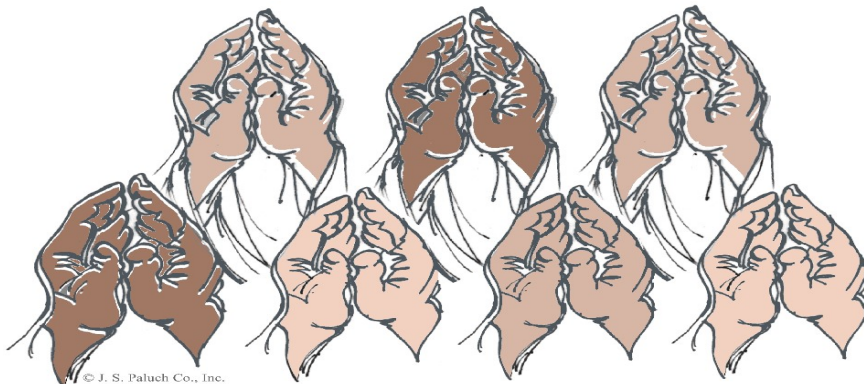

#### EYEWITNESSES

Today, the Feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord, is a day of eyewitness accounts. The first, a vision reported by the prophet Daniel, was well known to Jesus and his apostles. The vision account was written in quite mystical and figurative language. It is a vision of heaven, powerful and memorable. There are flames of fire, burning wheels, the Ancient One, and a Son of Man. Clearly, Daniel saw something. But was it a dream? Was it real? Was it merely a clever myth?

Peter wants no such confusion about his vision! We are told in Matthew's Gospel what he and his friends James and John saw when they went up on the mountain with Jesus one day. Jesus warned the three witnesses to tell no one until "the Son of Man has been raised from the dead" (Matthew 17:9). Lest readers of one of the Gospels discount the story or simply write it off as a pious myth, Peter gives his own account of the Transfiguration of Jesus in his second letter to the church. He writes with authority, as an eyewitness. He reports this message from God concerning Jesus: "This is my Son, my beloved, with whom I am well pleased," and he assures us that the message is "altogether reliable" (2 Peter 1:17, 19). #### TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

As the Latin Mass evolved in the first six centuries, the central prayer, what the Greeks called the *anaphora* and what we call today the Eucharistic Prayer, became fairly standard almost everywhere in the West. What we now know as Eucharistic Prayer I, or the Roman Canon, took a complex shape, not at all like the fluid and spontaneous prayers of early Rome, but a real architectural construction.

The city of Rome was in a terrible condition by that time, and a series of political upheavals, plagues, and invasions swept through. Not much of Rome's former glory was left standing, except for the pope, who became a symbol of protection and hope for the troubled people. The structures of law and administration were swept away in the chaos, and the pope gradually assumed authority to restore and maintain order. Soon, the public liturgy of Rome became the city's only glory. The Romans wanted "good order" not only in their civic life, but in their liturgy. One prayer, increasingly enriched by music (although when the music tried to overtake the prayer the pope banned musical instruments entirely) was the new rule of the day. That one prayer, the Roman Canon, was solidly in place when the first liturgical book we have, the Leonine Sacramentary of 540, was compiled.

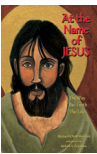

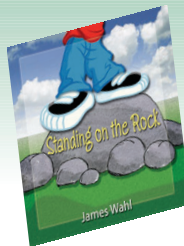
