Objectives: This lesson teaches the characteristic of a true servant and being a young champion today in a world of chaos. Children will learn how to serve others for the right reason as they become servant champions.

Theme: Transforming Children into spiritual Champions by:

- 1. Developing a servant's heart (Mark 10:45 and Acts 20:35)
 - What does it mean to be a servant?
 - The servant heart of Jesus: The essence of serving others is to have God's purpose direct us in how to think about and how to value others.
 - Compassion Jesus always did in having a servant's heart.
 - What is compassion?
 - The compassion of Jesus: Jesus taught parables that emphasized compassion.) Lk 10:30; 15:20)
 - He healed others because of compassion (MK 1:40-45; Mt 20:32-34)
 - He taught others because of compassion (MK 6:34) He wants His followers to have the same compassion.
- 2. Spiritual Heroes: Young champions of the Bible: David, Ruth, Samuel, Ishmael; Joseph when they were young
- 3. Ways to be champions (servants)
- 4. Wonderfully and fearfully made (the gifts and talents God has given children to help others.
- 5. Why should I want to serve God?
- 6. Understanding spiritual truths
