#1. I was best known as the voice of the St. Louis Cardinals baseball team for whom I broadcast games from 1954 through 2001. For my accomplishments in sports broadcasting, I am enshrined in the Baseball Hall of Fame, Football Hall of Fame, Missouri Sports Hall of Fame, and the Radio Hall of Fame.

#2. I was a gifted entertainer who gained world fame as the hobo clown, "Weary Willie." I found my true home in 1941 when he joined the Ringling Brothers and Barnum and Bailey Circus. I was inducted into the Clown Hall of Fame in 1989.
