 -Alabama is on a 7-0 SU and 4-3 ATS run vs Georgia since 2008. They've won the last two games by identical 41-24 scores.  
 -Alabama head coach Nick Saban is on a 5-1 SU/ATS run as an underdog since 2008.

† Georgia 28 Alabama 24. For all the problems that CFB has, at least the two best teams in the country (by far) will be deciding the National Championship. Obviously, this is a rematch of the SEC Championship game where Alabama upset Georgia 41-24 as 6-point underdogs. It was the first time since 2015 that Alabama was an underdog in a game. In fact, the only two times Alabama has been an underdog in their last 167 games have both come against Georgia and the Crimson Tide have won both games outright in comfortable fashion. In fact, Alabama has won 7 straight over Georgia since 2008 including the National Championship game 4 years ago. With the exception of the SEC Championship game, Georgia has looked like the best team in the country. The Bulldogs destroyed a red-hot Michigan team in the semi-finals. Meanwhile, Alabama didn't look dominant in the regular season including 4 close wins and a loss to Texas A&M. Their last two games, they have looked the part with easy wins and covers over a pair of unbeaten teams (UGA and Cincy). Our power ratings have Georgia by 2.8 so we don't see a ton of value here. We think Georgia is the sharper side but we've already seen early money bump them to -3 (opened in the -1.5, -2 range). However, is Alabama and Nick Saban in UGA's heads? Also the QB edge for Alabama is the biggest one on the board (see checklist). Still, we expect UGA to be the team to make more adjustments from the first meeting and the Tide are banged up including WR Metchie.

### HOME TEAM IN CAPS

#### Saturday, January 8th

**Dallas 24 PHILADELPHIA 16.** Both teams are heading to the playoffs but the Cowboys have already clinched the NFC East despite a loss to Arizona last week. Dallas looks like they will be the No. 4 seed while Philly will be the No. 6 or No. 7 seed and could rest some players here (hence the Cowboys being TD favorites on the road). Philly beat us last week on these pages despite trailing Washington 16-7 at halftime. Dallas destroyed Philly in the first meeting but we don't see much value this week.

**KANSAS CITY 28 Denver 16.** Kansas City needs a win (likely) and a Tennessee loss (unlikely) to get the No. 1 seed in the AFC. They lost control of the top spot thanks to a last-second loss to Cincinnati as the Chiefs blew a 14-point lead. That stopped their 8-game win streak. The Chiefs have simply owned this series vs Denver with 12 straight wins (10-2 ATS). The Broncos were eliminated from the playoffs last week and their offense is struggling. Lean Chiefs especially in the first half.

#### Sunday, January 9th

**Green Bay 23 DETROIT 20.** The Packers have already clinched the No. 1 seed in the NFC. Will Aaron Rodgers play in this game for Green Bay? The market seems to think he is doubtful as this line opened Green Bay -11. However, we did see some money come in on Green Bay just an hour or so ago. Detroit is off one of their worst performances of the season but they have played hard all year long for head coach Dan Campbell (10-6 ATS).

**2★ MINNESOTA 25 Chicago 20.** Just announced on Wednesday morning, it looks like the Vikings will be playing their starters in this game including QB Kirk Cousins. Cousins missed last week's game (COVID) at Green Bay which eliminated the Vikings from the playoffs. Chicago crushed us on these pages last week as they have won back-to-back games. Still, this should be the final game of the Matt Nagy era. These two played on MNF a few weeks ago and it was one of the ugliest games of the entire season. Still we have the much better team at home (laying a FG) that looks like they will play their starters. We will back Minnesota off the breaking news.

**New England 22 MIAMI 17.** We won our top play on these pages last week fading Miami in their blowout loss to Tennessee. New England was on the opposite end of the spectrum crushing Jacksonville by 40. New England needs a win here and a loss by Buffalo (unlikely) to win the division. Miami has been eliminated from the playoffs. Miami beat NE back in Week 1 17-16 as 3-point dogs. That was the Dolphins only win over an above .500 team. Does Belichick pull starters if the Bills get out to a big lead? Plus New England is on a 2-7 SU run at Miami in December/January.

**Indianapolis 30 JACKSONVILLE 13.** The Colts simply need to win and they are in. They are coming off the shocking loss to the Raiders last week. Meanwhile, it looks like Jacksonville has officially waved the white flag on the season. They are on a 0-7 SU and 0-7 ATS run losing their games by an average of 19.4 ppg. The offense has been abysmal averaging 11.1 ppg in that stretch with Lawrence throwing just 2 TD passes the last 9 weeks!

**BUFFALO 30 N.Y. Jets 13.** The Bills are the one team in the NFL you shouldn't hesitate to lay points with. They are No. 1 in scoring margin and all 10 of their wins have come by 12 points or more including a 45-17 win over the Jets in Week 9. The Bills need a win to clinch the division and won by 14 last week despite 3 INT's by QB Josh Allen. Meanwhile, the Jets put forth a big effort last week in a near-upset of Tampa Bay. Can they replicate it?

**TAMPA BAY 24 Carolina 15.** The Bucs look to have the No. 3 seed essentially locked up. How much do the starters play in this one? The early money seems to think they don't play much as Tampa went from 16.5 down to 8-point favorites. Carolina is on a 2-11 SU and 2-11 ATS run including 6 straight non-covers. How much does the Antonio Brown drama impact Tampa? Pass for now.

**Tennessee 28 HOUSTON 16.** It's quite simple for Tennessee, a win here and they clinch the No. 1 seed in the AFC. Remarkable considering their extremely banged up roster this season. Last week we won with them as our top play on these pages as they destroyed Miami. Keep in mind, they don't have as much urgency in this game if KC loses to Denver on Saturday (unlikely). The Titans have revenge for losing to Houston earlier this season as they were -5 in TO's in that game.

**Washington 23 N.Y. GIANTS 15.** We lost backing both of these teams last week. Some of you may have won with Washington as the line moved against us big time (obviously, we always count W/L from what we release it at). Meanwhile, the Giants no-showed at Chicago in a blowout loss. That's now 5 straight losses (also 0-5 ATS) by an average of 18.4 ppg. We think Washington is the right side but don't think there is a ton of value here. Maybe tease Washington down to -1.

**NEW ORLEANS 21 Atlanta 17.** New Orleans kept their slim playoff hopes alive with a win last week over a feeble Carolina team. Meanwhile, Atlanta's offense continues to struggle as they were officially eliminated from playoff contention. Totals' players note the UNDER has cashed in 7 of Atlanta's last 8 games and has cashed in 6 straight New Orleans games.

**BALTIMORE 23 Pittsburgh 17.** Both teams still have faint playoff hopes. Baltimore's recent bad luck continued last week as they lost by 1-point to the Rams. That's now 5 straight losses and 4 of them have been by 2-points or less. Meanwhile, Pittsburgh had an emotional win on MNF in the final home game for Ben Roethlisberger. Despite the win, he looked feeble throwing anything past 10 yards averaging just 2.7 yards per attempt. Does Lamar Jackson return for this one? We lean Baltimore.

**CLEVELAND 23 Cincinnati 16.** As of press-time it looks like Cleveland will be going with Case Keenum at QB and also Cincinnati looks like it will rest its starters including QB Joe Burrow. We don't think Keenum is a downgrade from how poor Mayfield has been playing as of late. Meanwhile, Cincy is off their biggest win in years, a last-second come-from-behind win over the Chiefs that clinched the division. We lean Cleveland with the current news.

**ARIZONA 27 Seattle 21.** The Cardinals need a win here and a Rams loss to clinch the NFC West. They're coming off one of their biggest wins of the season upsetting the Cowboys as near TD-underdogs. Meanwhile, Seattle is having their worst season in a decade but are coming off a blowout win albeit over the lowly Lions. Could this be the final game for Pete Carroll and Russell Wilson in Seattle. We don't see much value.

**3★ San Fran (plus the points) L.A. RAMS 23 San Francisco 22.** The 49ers are in the playoffs with a win here while the Rams need a win to clinch the division. San Francisco has owned the Rams as of late with 5 straight wins (4-1 ATS). It hasn't been fluky either as the 49ers have won those 5 games by an average of 9.6 ppg. Rams had to go the full 60 minutes last week at Baltimore while the 49ers had a comfortable win over Houston. We like the 49ers as our top play of the week.

**2★ L.A. CHARGERS 28 Las Vegas 23.** A win by either team here and they are in the playoffs. The Raiders have been outscored by 4.3 ppg on the season (Chargers +1.1). They have been really fortunate in their current 3-game win streak as they faced a short-handed Cleveland team that was down to a 3rd string QB. They beat a Denver team without Teddy Bridgewater. Last week, they pulled a shocker at Indianapolis but Colts QB Carson Wentz didn't practice all week (COVID). The Raiders have made the playoffs one time in the last 19 years and it will be interesting to see how they handle the pressure. We also like the OVER.
