Buck has been very instrumental in promoting horseshoes throughout the state and everywhere he travels. He started pitching in the early 1980's. Became a member of NCHPA in 1986. Since that time has won many trophies and awards. In the early 80's he had four courts in his backyard where there was horseshoe pitching every week-end. In 1990 he married his wife Rivers and now they have one outside court and a building that houses two courts that are in use winter and summer. From 1986 until 1991 I have no record of his accomplishments, but there were many.
