**To: All CRCWD (Castle Rock County Water District) customers,**

Please be advised that while canal (untreated) water availability began this past Thursday, April 8th, we have identified a leak in the Redwood tank at Borges Ranch. This means that service will be intermittent for a number of days pending repair.

When repairs are completed, and hopefully in a few days, we will post it on our web page at "[CRCWD.org](http://CRCWD.org)". Please check regularly for the latest information on the availability of normal service.

Your email address and telephone number are under the custodial care of our bookkeeper and not released to any third party.

Since a very limited amount of water was available during the first quarter we will not be mailing invoices for the first quarter. However, since CCWD (Contra Costa Water District) has billed us for their service charge (they spread their annual service charge over the four quarters) your Q2 invoice will include service charges for both the first and second quarters.

We are very pleased that five customers volunteered to serve as Directors of your CRCWD. they replace the directors who have retired or plan to retire over the next few months. The new directors will be identified on our web page as the transfer of responsibilities take place.

Lastly, we are grateful for the many years of service that Fred Allen committed to CRCWD as a director and chair. Fred did it all and we thank him for his service.
