


Hoosier Racing Tire and Simpson Race Products have again teamed up and are offering 4 different Hoosier Tire Firesuits. These are SFI 5, One Piece, Two Layer Firesuits, specially designed and priced for our Hoosier Tire Customers. Two piece suits are also available for an up charge.



# Firesuit A

This is a black suit with silver sleeves and epaulets along with purple trim. It is offered at a special price of \$575.00 each.



# Firesuit B

This is a black suit with purple stripes down the sides from the shoulders to the ankles. This suit is offered at a special price of \$650.00 each.



### Firesuit C

Our newest design is a black suit with thin purple stripes running the entire length of the suit, coming to a point on the bottom of the legs & then going back up the suit. This suit is offered at the special price of \$720.00 each.



## Firesuit D

This is the same design as Firesuit D but with an upgrade to silver nomex on the sides. The silver upgrade adds \$100 to the cost. This suit is offered at the special price of \$820.00 each. All four firesuits are SFI 5 rated, constructed of Twill Nomex Fabric and come standard as a One Piece, with Straight Leg Cuffs and Full 360 degree Shoulder Gussets.

The following six options are available on all suits for an additional price:

- Option 1: Back Gusset (a stretch panel in the back at waist level to help when bending and moving.) This option is an additional \$50.00
- **Option 2: Built In Arm Restraints**. This option is an additional **\$50.00**
- Option 3: Satin Material Upgrade. This option is an additional \$125.00
- **Option 4: Two Piece Firesuit**. This option is an additional **\$35.00**
- **Option 5: FIA Certification.** This option is an additional **\$170.00** and has no piping on the suit, as it is not allowed by FIA.

#### There will also be a \$100.00 up charge to any firesuit that has any measurements greater than 50".

### No other options or embroidery are available on these program suits.

However, If you would like to add any embroidery locally, after you receive your suit, that is fine.

If you would like a suit built for you, please fill out the attached measurement form with your sizes as well as your shipping address (No P.O. Boxes) and your phone number. On the measurement form, please indicate which suit choice you would like as well as from which distributor you buy your tires, i.e.: Hoosier Tire Midwest, Hoosier Tire Western Canada or Hoosier Tire North, etc.

# <u>Measurement Tips</u>

- 1. If at all possible, have a professional measure you such as a suit tailor or a seamstress. Try to go to a dress shop or a tuxedo shop and ask them to measure you.
- 2. If you have a family member or friend measure you, please be sure to use a cloth tape measure. You can buy one of these at a Wal-Mart or a craft store like Jo-Ann's or Michaels.
- 3. Always make accurate measurements. Do not add to the measurements because you would "like a looser fitting suit." When they construct the suit, allowances are made & they add to make the suit fit properly. If you add and then they add the suit will inevitably not fit and we want you to be happy with your new Hoosier Firesuit.
- 4. The person being measured needs to always be looking straight forward and not down at who is measuring. This is very important on all measurements but is crucial on Measurement "F" (Collar bone to where crotch meets) When you look down some measurements, especially "F", will shorten up and when you get your suit it will be rather short, tight or not fit at all. This is a very important step in custom measuring.
- 5. For measurement "M" (The Rise), imagine a dowel rod through your belly button and out your back. Measure from where it would enter at your belly button down and around to where it would exit your back. That will be the most accurate measurement for "M".
- 6. Do not be worried if your inseam or waist measurements do not match your pants size. They rarely do.
