Dear Player,

Welcome to Hertford Heath Rangers Netball Club - we are pleased you will be joining us!

This letter contains some important and useful information about the club and we would be very grateful for you attention to the details below.

Senior Netball

Hertford Heath Rangers was formed in 1992 as a senior's team and in 2005 we introduced the junior section, which has proven to be a great success and the club is ever-growing. Training is held on Tuesday evenings (please refer to the Training Calendar on our website for dates) at Sele School in Hertford and once a player has settled in and is of a standard ready to participate in matches, they will play in local and/or county league netball. We enter various leagues; with senior player matches typically taking place at Wormley Playing Fields in Wormley, Wodson Park in Ware or Stanborough School/Sir Frederic Osborn School in Welwyn during the week or Saturday mornings, depending on the league(s) entered. Directions to league venues can be found on our website.

England Netball CAPS (Club Action Planning Scheme) Accredited to Sport England Clubmark

We are a CAPS accredited Club and this prestigious accreditation is only given to clubs who can demonstrate that they are offering a good quality netball provision within their community. We believe in a relaxed and friendly ethos and feel it is important that; first and foremost, every member enjoys and finds playing netball fun and that they are committed, not just to the club but to their team-mates – this is something we are very proud of.

England Netball Affiliation and Club Membership

Current Club Membership and Affiliation Fees can be obtained from our website under 'Member Information – Player Forms'. Club Membership covers the cost of matches, training, some league tournaments, officials and administration (other costs such as kit and tours etc will be paid separately). Membership fees are split half yearly payable by 1 September and 1 March. An affiliation fee also needs to be paid to the England Netball Association through us. Player affiliation includes Comprehensive Liability and Personal Accident insurance cover.

Playing Kit

Our team colours are Navy and Turquoise and once a player has settled in and become part of a team, a kit will be organised. Players must fill in a Kit Order Form via our website.

It is the parent/guardians responsibility to ensure that their daughter is wearing the correct footwear, cuts her nails and wears **no** jewellery when playing netball. This is for every player's safety and we would appreciate it if every player adheres to these rules. Match officials will not allow any player to participate in league matches if they are wearing jewellery or incorrect playing kit or footwear.

Player Medical and Contact Details / Codes of Conduct

It is important that we are kept up to date with player contact details and any medical conditions we should be aware of. We would be very grateful if the following forms could be completed and returned to us as soon as possible:

- Senior Medical Contact Form
- England Netball Registration Form

It is also important that each player familiarises themselves with the Codes of Conduct forms which can be found under the Constitution section of our website.

Club Communication

To help keep paperwork to a minimum, we aim to send all correspondence via email and we hope you will find this method of communication convenient. Should you change your email address, please keep us updated and remember if you change your home address, to also keep us updated for affiliation purposes. We would appreciate sufficient notice should you decide to leave the club to enable us to sort out any paperwork and to find replacement player(s) for the team if necessary.

We have a website www.hertfordheathrangers.com which we urge you to regularly check for information you may need such as team fixtures, training dates, league tables and upcoming events etc. The website acts as the main source of information for all club news and is updated regularly. We also have a Facebook group which we urge all members to join if they are on Facebook - this acts as a good social tool for members to communicate with one another and write up match reports. We send text messages and use Facebook messenger to confirm player availability for matches.
