



## ARONIMINK SWIM CLUB – GREEN PHASE PLAN **[BEGINNING 6/29/20]**

Dear Members of ASC,

On Monday, June 29, 2020, ASC will begin its Green Phase Plan for the Summer of 2020. The enclosed pages contain the details of the plan for this phase. It has been great to see our members enjoying the pool so far this summer, and we hope that you and your families will continue to do so.

The highlights of the changes we will make during the Green Phase are as follows:

- We will increase our daily capacity to 600 members at any one time
- We will modify our pool capacity numbers for each section of the pool
- We will provide additional seating on our lower level to accommodate social distancing guidelines and possible larger crowds
- We will open our pool slide once it is operational
- We will open our playground for use; we will clean it daily during the 3:00 – 4:00 PM hour
- We will permit basketball, ping pong, and beach volleyball; members will need to bring their own equipment to play (ASC will not provide any shared objects this season)
- Swim Team will return to activities beginning July 6, 2020
- Water Aerobics classes will begin pending finalization of details for dates and times, etc.
- Arts and Crafts classes will begin pending finalization of details for dates and times, etc.
- Private swim lessons can take place provided the skill of the swimmers allow for proper distancing between instructors and participants.
- Guests will not be permitted at ASC until further notice.

As we prepare to move into the Green Phase, we ask that all members help our staff and each other with the following procedures and guidelines:

- When entering the club, wear your masks/cloth face covers until you arrive at your seated location
- When using the restrooms, snack bar, or moving to locations where physical distancing is not possible, wear your masks/cloth face covers
- When exiting the club, wear your masks/cloth face covers
- Parents and caregivers – for the safety of others, it is always your responsibility to actively monitor and regulate social distancing with your children.
- Regarding our **Green-Yellow-Red** flag system for pool capacity limits, it would greatly help if swimmers did not enter sections of the pool that reach the **Red Flag** capacity level. Once the section returns to **yellow** or **green**, swimmers can enter that section of the pool again.

## **PROCEDURES FOR 2020 SEASON** **GREEN PHASE**

ASC will implement the following new procedures and guidelines for the 2020 Season during the state government's **Green Phase** for re-opening:

### **CLUB HOURS**

Club hours will remain the same as during the Yellow Phase

- 9:00 AM: Members 60 & Over have early entry to swim in our pools
  - 10:00 AM – 3:00 PM: Club is open to all members
  - 3:00 PM – 4:00 PM: Pools / facilities are closed for cleaning/disinfecting
  - 4:00 PM – 9:00 PM: Club re-opens to all members
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### **9:00 AM OPENING FOR 60 & OVER**

- Beginning 6/13/20, we opened our club to members 60 & Over for early entry into the club at 9AM; we will continue this policy for the remainder of the summer.
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### **CLUB CAPACITY DURING** **GREEN PHASE**

- To meet state guidelines during the GREEN phase, ASC will allow a maximum of 600 members into the club at any time

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### **FRONT OFFICE CHECK-IN / CHECK-OUT**

- Members entering the club should use the entrance ramp down to the front office. When exiting the club, members should use the stairs. Members who need access to the ramp upon exiting the club can do so if needed.
  - All members must show their membership card upon entry. Front office staff members will ask entering members for the following information:
    - Your membership number (printed on all membership tickets)
    - All entering members show their card
    - # of people entering the club at that time on your current membership
  - Members who need wrist bands after passing their deep-water test will need to show their card to get their wrist band as they have in the past.
  - When leaving the club, we ask that members check out at the ticket office and let front office staff members know your membership number and how many members are leaving with you.
  - Guests at ASC are prohibited until further notice.
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### **DECK SEATING**

- We will continue to have our modified deck seating to provide for enough space for members to remain at least six (6) feet apart from those with whom they do not live.
  - Families/members can choose from an umbrella seating area, bench area, or awning area for their seating.
  - Seating is also available on the lower levels of the club if needed.
  - ASC will clean and disinfect all deck chairs on a regular basis.
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## CLOTH FACE COVERINGS / MASKS

- ASC will require all staff and club members to wear cloth face coverings/masks at our club this summer during the following times:
  - Entering/exiting the club (keep masks on until you arrive at your seated location)
  - Moving around the club (bathrooms, snack bar area, or when physical distancing is difficult)
- Cloth face coverings are not required when you are seated at your chair area
- Do not wear cloth face coverings/masks when swimming in the water

## SANITIZING PROCEDURES

- Our staff will clean, disinfect, and prepare our club for opening every morning
- Our staff will schedule quick cleanings of high contact areas every two hours or as needed
- To maintain cleanliness and proper disinfection of our facilities, we will close our club from 3 – 4 PM daily (see below for more details)
- Prior to closing each night, our staff will clean and organize our club for opening the next day

## CLOSING FROM 3:00 – 4:00 PM

- We will continue to close our club daily from 3 – 4 PM to allow our staff to perform a full cleaning of the club
- Members must vacate the club with their belongings during this hour
- We recommend that members decide to attend the club for either a morning/afternoon experience (10 AM – 3 PM) or an afternoon/evening experience (4 PM – 9 PM)
- If our club attendance is lower than usual (less than 100 members), the club will remain open for the 3:00 – 4:00 PM time slot

## SOCIAL DISTANCING AT ASC

- We have arranged our deck chairs and lower-level tables to allow for social distancing
- Swimmers must also practice social distancing while using our pools. We will enforce the following capacities in each of our swimming zones at our club during the **Green Phase:**

BABY POOL	BIG POOL [Shallow End]	BIG POOL [Deeper End]	BIG POOL [Diving Well]	ADULT POOL
36	60	40	36	45

- If any of these sections of our pool exceed the stated capacities, our lifeguards may whistle out that section of the pool for 2 minutes to reset the capacity in that section of the pool

- We ask all members to respect our capacity limits and to remember to share the pool for all to enjoy

## SHARED OBJECTS IN THE POOL

- ASC will permit the use of toys in the Baby Pool only. We ask that parents and caregivers clean up the toys after use and not share them. ASC will not keep/store any toys left behind.
- ASC will NOT permit the use of toys or shared objects (diving sticks, balls, etc.) in the Big Pool
- ASC will NOT distribute kick boards for adult members to use in our adult pool. Adult members can bring in their own kickboard for Adult Pool use only.

## THE BIG POOL DIVING WELL

- The Big Pool Diving Well will run on the following general schedule for the **Green Phase** of our season:

9:00 – 10:00 AM	Lap Swimming for <u>60 &amp; Over</u> swimmers
10:00 AM – 12:00 PM	Lap Swimming Only
12:00 PM – 3:00 PM	Diving Board & Slide will open for use
4:00 – 7:00 PM	Diving Board & Slide will open for use
7:00 – 9:00 PM	Lap Swimming Only

## ACTIVITIES STATUS

- The playground area will open for daily use; it will be cleaned once per day during the 3:00 – 4:00 PM hour.
- Tennis courts and bang boards are available and open for members to play tennis
- Basketball courts are open for use; members must bring their own basketball. ASC will not provide basketballs for members to use.
- Beach Volleyball is open for members to use; members must bring their own ball. ASC will not provide volleyballs for members to use.
- Ping Pong tables are available for play; members must bring their own paddles and ball to play. ASC will not provide ping pong equipment for members to play.
- Arts & Crafts classes will take place pending finalization of procedures for return
- Water Aerobics will take place pending finalization of procedures for return

## SWIM LESSONS

- Group swim lessons will not take place until further notice
- Private swim lessons can take place provided the skill of the swimmers allow for proper distancing between instructors and participant(s).

## WEATHER EVACUATIONS

- In the event of a weather emergency / thunderstorm, members will need to evacuate the club for at least 30 minutes due to the lack of safe shelter for large crowds
