Water Turned into Wine

If wine is the goal, you then cannot remain a grape unless you are destined to become a raisin.

Just like the natural grape, be willing to go further with the water to get new wine. You cannot deny that water is incomparable to new wine. Characteristics of new wine are: better fragrance, better flavor, better pigmentation, better effect, better texture, and better value.

As you may recall in John 2:1-11, Jesus turned water into wine at the wedding in Cana. When the finished product was presented to the governor, he thought it was the best that he had tasted. Being in charge of the wedding, he wondered why they had saved the best for last. With the help of the indwelling Holy Spirit, you will begin to realize God created you exclusively for the end time harvest. Ultimately, others will recognize Jesus saved the best for last. You are the miracle that Jesus Christ desires to use in these latter days. For you, the best is yet to come.

“O taste and see that the Lord is good: blessed is the man that trusts in him.” Psalm 34:8.

Fellowship with the Holy Spirit

The transformation you make from a living soul to a life-giving spirit assimilates the chemical change that takes place when wine is fermented. The living organism within that process produces the agent that is needed for transformation. The agent in this case is the Spirit of God. You will not be the same. In this, you become a priceless treasure to the

Lord. The new wine will cause you to walk the straight and narrow road, and not reel to and fro like a drunken man.

The Holy Spirit is the third person of the Trinity: working with God, the Father and Jesus Christ, the Son. The Holy Spirit is a person. Only people can produce life; not places or things. So begin to refer to the Holy Spirit as the “life producing person”, not an “it.”

Because the Holy Spirit is oftentimes referred to as the Holy Ghost, many equate Him as being spooky or scary, even being some kind of phantom. In reality, the Holy Spirit helps take the mystery out of life. The Holy Spirit enables you to move with precision.

The Holy Spirit is the Comforter Jesus sent to closely work with us on earth. Jesus said, “And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you forever.” John 14:16

The Holy Spirit is the advance payment you receive from God as an active part of your inheritance. God seals His agreement with us by the Holy Spirit. So the Holy Spirit is the conduit God uses to demonstrate His power in the earth. His sustaining power and authority will remain in effect for all eternity.

“For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father.” Romans 8:15. The Spirit of adoption shows God’s commitment to raise us up as His own children. In other words, everything that was available to Jesus Christ as

His Son is also available to us. We now have the status of a preferred child.

We have access to the same Spirit, the same Power, but Jesus promised that we would have greater results than what He demonstrated on earth. “If there be therefore any consolation in Christ, if any comfort of love, if any fellowship of the Spirit, if any bowels and mercies. Fulfill ye my joy, that ye be like-minded, having the same love, being of one accord, of one mind.” Phillipians 2:1-2.

If you receive the same Spirit, you will also produce the same image. The Spirit of God takes us from glory to glory. He takes no uncharted course, but leads us in the paths of righteousness for His name sake. 2 Corthinians 3:17-18 confirms this when it declared, “Now the Lord is that Spirit; and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty. But we all, with open face beholding as in a glass the glory of the Lord, are changed into the same image from glory to glory, even as by the Spirit of the Lord.”

Although invisible, you can be reassured of His presence once you offer Him occupancy and fellowship. John 14:17 states, “Even the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you.”

The Holy Spirit is also an approved channel of communications with God. The Holy Spirit helps maintain effective communications between heaven and earth. You can trust the Holy Spirit to be the:

- Bearer of only truth
- Everlasting escort for life's journey
- Mouthpiece for God
- Maintains unity with God
- Never operates independently
- Previews the road ahead

“Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come.” John 16:13

Jesus Christ purchased a fitting dwelling place for God to live. He had us in mind before the foundation of the world. When royalty comes to town, you only offer Him the best place to stay. “What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost, which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own? For ye are bought with a price; therefore glorify God in your body and in your spirit, which are God's,” I Corinthians 6:19-20.

To glorify God in your body and in your spirit, you must do as Romans 12:1-2 entreats, “I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. And be not conformed to this world, but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.”

Romans 12:1 details the purpose of God. We must be totally committed to God as a gift: reserved only for Him, tailor-

made only for Him, and serving only His needs. And Romans 12:2 describes the plan of God. We have been commissioned to demonstrate that His design for us is beneficial, tailor-made, and satisfying.

Seamless Connection with the Spirit

“But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth; for the Father seeketh such to worship him. God is a spirit; and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth.” John 4:23-24.

God is supernatural, so expect more than just the natural to happen in your life. If God is in Jesus, and Jesus is in you by the indwelling of the Holy Spirit, then you have a seamless connection. The decision is solely up to you how well the image of God’s character, fruit, and power is fully developed within.

One cord represents mankind left to himself. Ultimately, it will lead him to death and destruction if he remains unconnected.

Two cords represent mankind that binds together with something or someone other than God. There is no real connection, just a twisting effect. It is temporary, so it cannot hold you. If God is not your source, whatever or whomever you are trusting, even if it is your own self, will eventually unravel.

Three cords represent mankind that binds together with Jesus through the indwelling Spirit. “A threefold cord is not quickly broken.” Ecclesiastes 4:12. That man

will fully experience God's character, fruit, and power. The braiding together will cause Jesus to rub off on you. With the intertwining, others won't see where you end and God begins. You will become hidden in Christ, truly developing a seamless connection with the Spirit of God.

Isaiah 40:31 declares, "But they that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run and not be weary; and they shall walk and not faint." In the Hebrew language the word "wait" is translated as "bind together."

You bind together to achieve oneness. You bind together to rely on God's strength, not your own. You bind together to associate with and assimilate Jesus Christ. You bind together to serve God.

Worship is a lifestyle of serving God, very much similar to how a "waiter" functions in a restaurant. The success of a waiter is strictly dependent upon where he is positioned so he can easily be summoned by the one being served. The waiter makes a seamless connection when the one being attended feels like he is the only one being served although there may be an entire section. Ultimately, it shows that there is an unbroken bond between the two parties.

To bind together with God, you may need to:

1. Make necessary adjustments where you differ
2. Strive for consistency with the kingdom of God
3. Seek to be similar
4. Achieve harmony

5. Be in complete accord
6. Carry the identity of Jesus Christ

Worship has been designed to have: your spirit with the Spirit of God to reign as king, your soul to be a faithful servant, and your flesh to be a slave. What hinders us from binding together with God?

1. The spirit of man longs for the connection with God. That is the part that connects you to God for the purpose of worship. However, it may be either undernourished or dead. Learn to connect to the Spirit of God.

2. The soul of man is renewed to have fellowship with Jesus through the Holy Spirit. The soul is the mind, will, and emotions. Learn to connect through the Word of God.

3. The body must be reckoned dead. Your flesh wars against your spirit. Your flesh must continually surrender to the Holy Spirit. The flesh must die daily for your spirit and soul to keep their connection. Disconnect from all fleshly desires that attempt to reign as king in your life.

You can establish a seamless connection with the Lord through the Holy Spirit. In doing so, there will be noticeable similarities. In fact, you can be so well connected that absolutely nothing will be able to come between you and Jesus Christ.
