Ivy Tech Community College's Bloomington campus will host a free information session for area residents to learn more about tuition-free job certifications at 6 p.m. March 31, Room C130D.

Ivy Tech Community College provides the opportunity for eligible Indiana residents to earn tuition-free certifications that lead to high-wage, high-demand jobs, and count toward associate degrees.

Certifications are paid for by the Workforce Ready Grant through Next Level Jobs Indiana. Certification programs include medical assisting, EMT, welding, automotive repair, and cyber security to name a few. These programs allow Ivy Tech graduates to start new jobs quickly, in a field aligned with the state's in-demand industries.

Attendees will learn more about Workforce Ready Grant eligible programs and requirements, one of which includes not having previously earned a college certification or degree. Ivy Tech accepts applications year-round and has multiple start dates. The next round of eight-week classes start March 16 — there is still time to apply to the college and sign up for classes.
