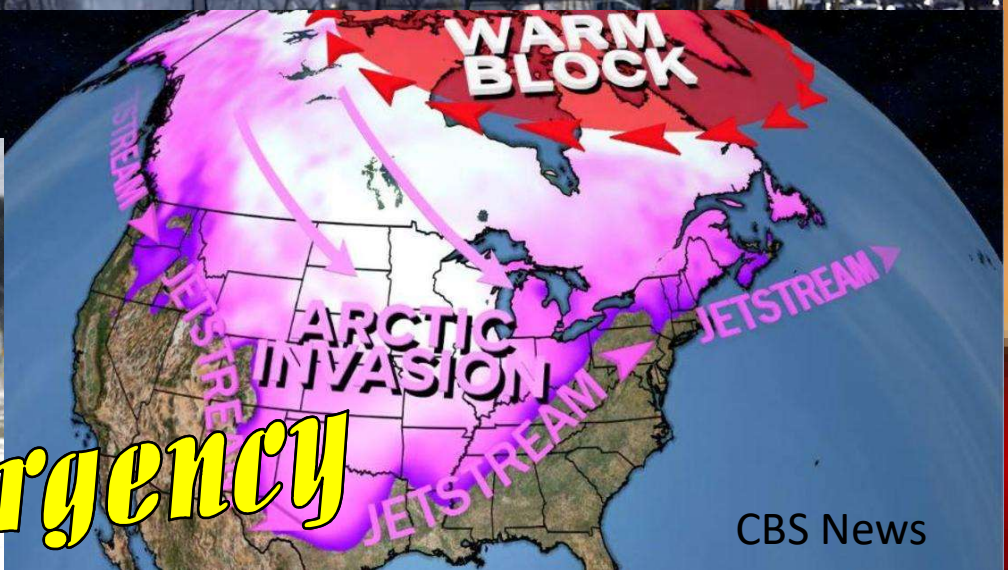

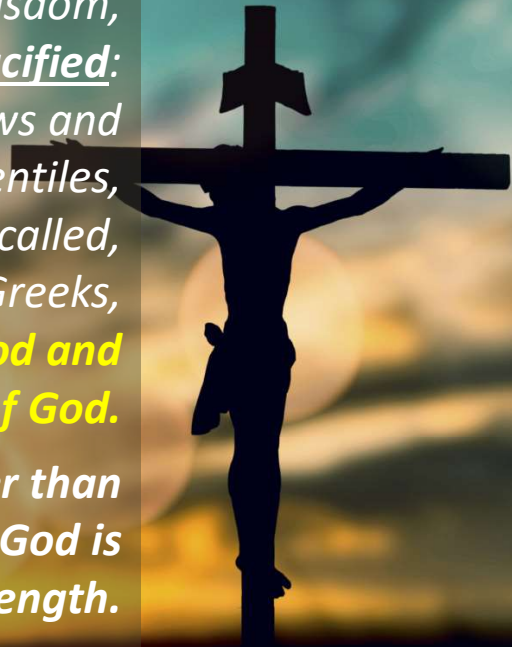

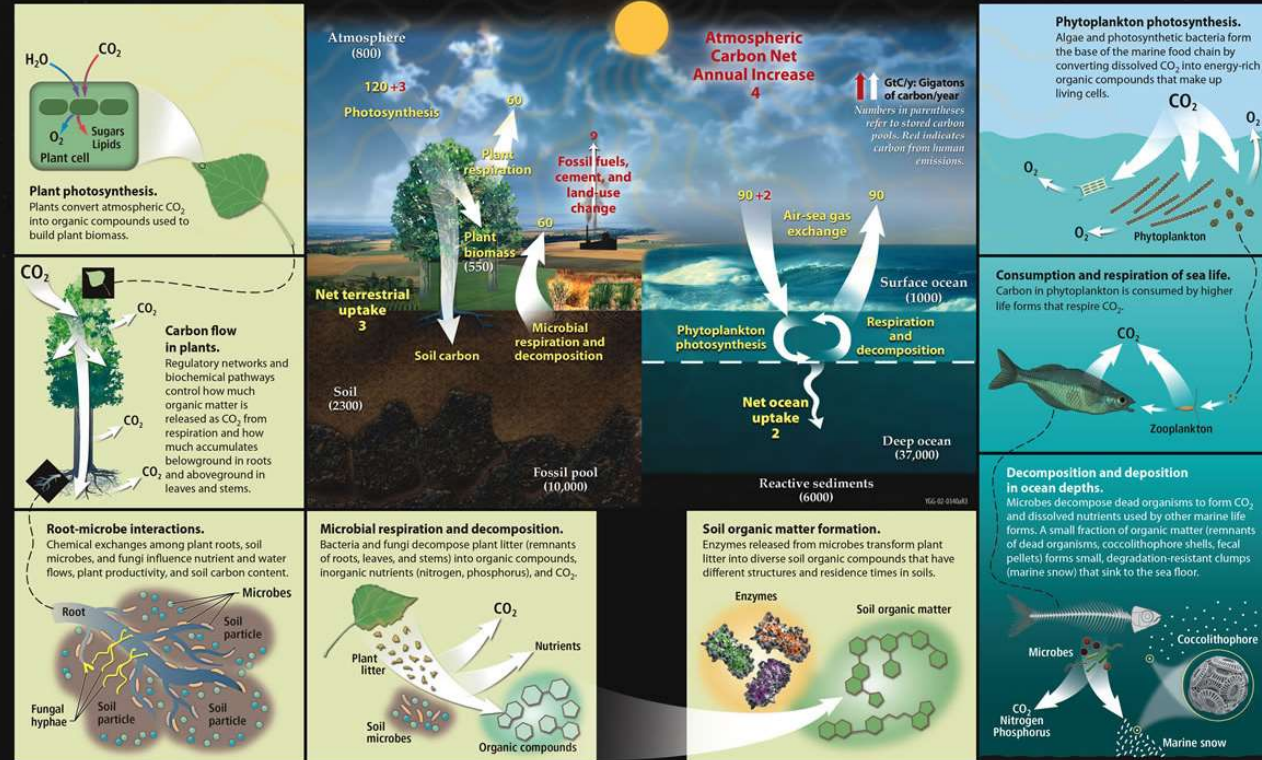

Components of the Global Carbon Cycle



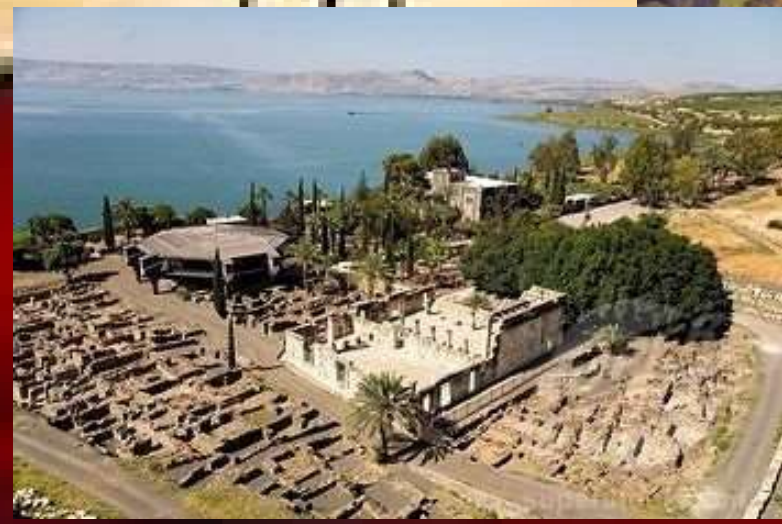
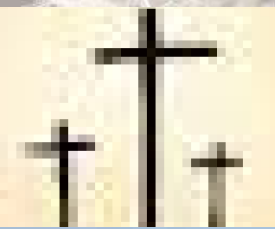

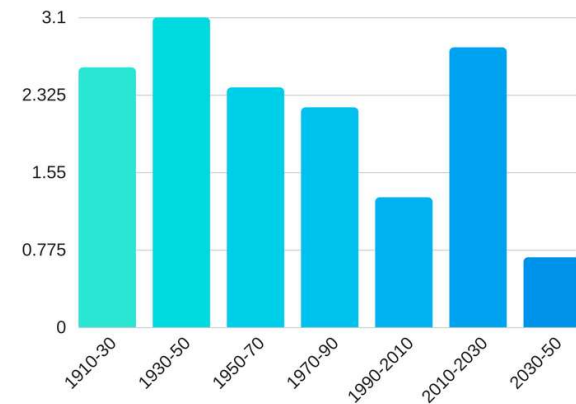

Average annual growth rate (in percent) of the elderly population: 1910-30 to 2030-50



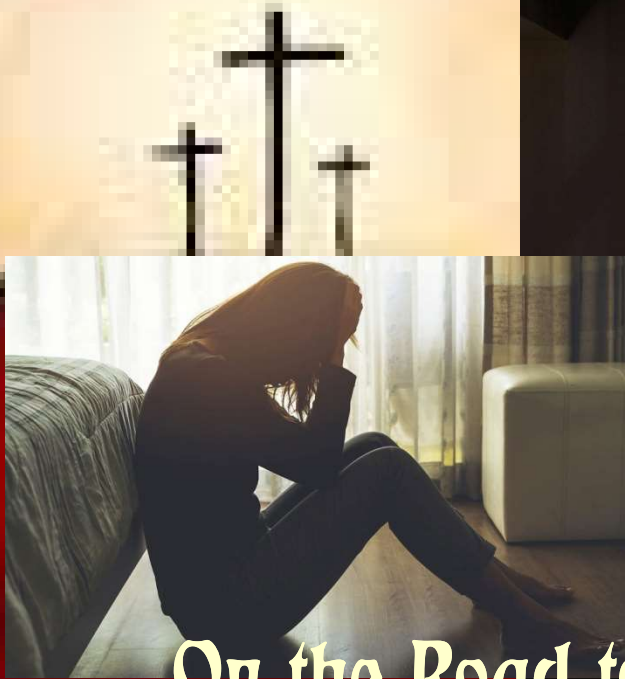
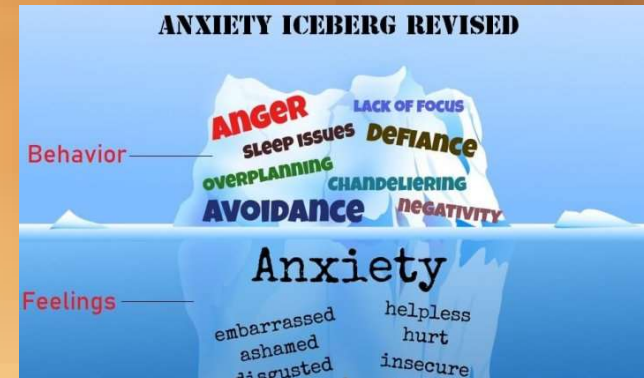
Major causes of elderly depression
