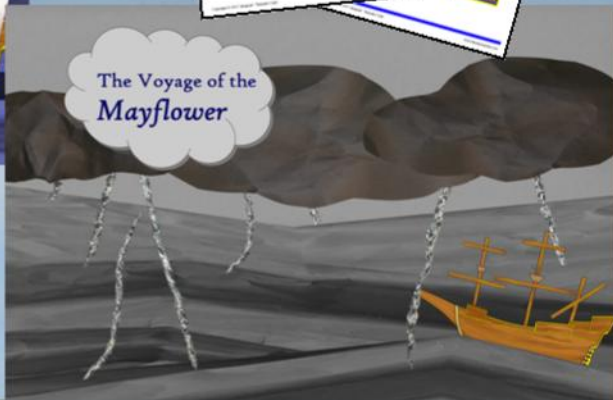

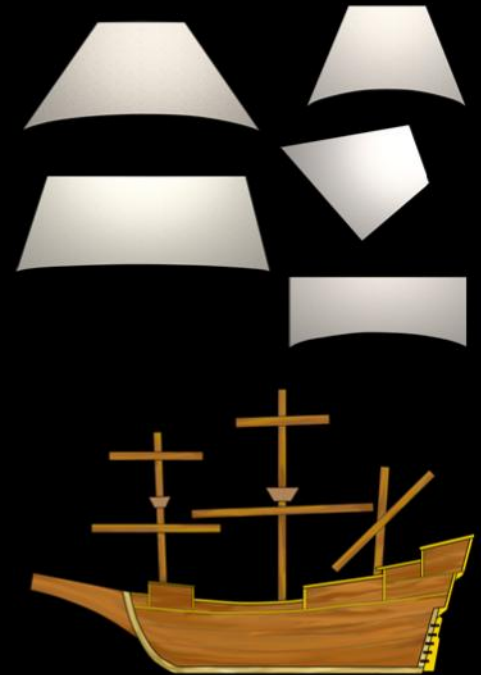

The Mayflower Mural Sunny Travel



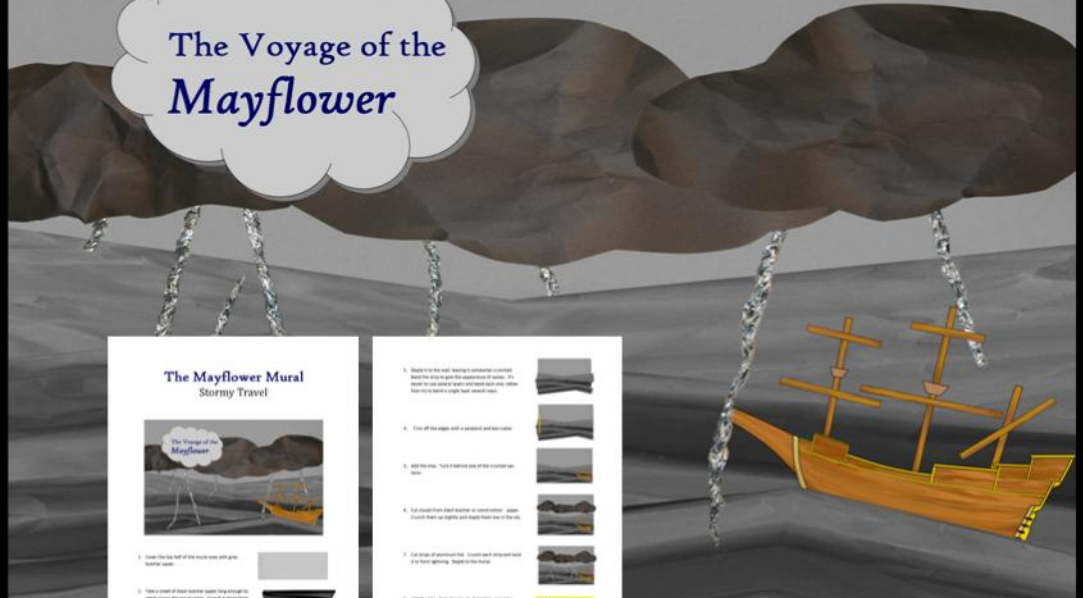
1. Glue the top half of the cloud to the wall (light blue background).
2. Take a sheet of white paper (use paper that is slightly larger than the mural area). Trace a white paper hull to follow the shape of the hull.

3. Paste the sails to the wall, leaving a consistent amount of space between them and the wall.
4. Add the sea. Use blue paper to create the sea. Use a blue marker to draw the sea.
5. Add the sky. Use light blue paper to create the sky. Use a blue marker to draw the sky.
6. Add the sun. Use yellow paper to create the sun. Use a yellow marker to draw the sun.
7. Add the clouds. Use white paper to create the clouds. Use a white marker to draw the clouds.
