UMPIRING FOR PHOENIX IN 2018

Umpire registrations for the 2018 season are now open and we welcome new and returning umpires back for another season.

If you are interested in joining Phoenix's group of umpires this season and having fun while developing your skills, please complete the information below in full, noting your experience level (to help us place you at the right level) and send the information to <u>phoenixnetballclubgc@gmail.com</u>.

- Your name
- Your date of birth (note: umpires must be turning 13 years or older in 2018)
- Your contact mobile number
- A parent/guardian's name and contact mobile number
- Your current umpiring level
- Any requests you have (e.g. how many games you would like to be rostered for, if you play or coach in another team, etc)
- Your account details for umpiring payments (i.e. BSB and Account Number)

New to Umpiring

If you are new to umpiring, the Club will review your details along with our Umpiring Co-ordinator / Coach. You will then be contacted to let you know if we have space in our umpire trainee program.

<u>Please note</u>: Trainee umpire positions are limited each season, so make sure you submit your details as soon as possible to avoid disappointment.

Before you begin umpiring you will need to:

- Completed the Basic Introduction to Junior Umpiring Course at NGCNA (or equivalent)
 - See below for more information on course details
- Complete the following courses (available via MyNetball under "Learning"):
 - Rules of Netball Theory Examination (note: pass mark of 70% or more required)

• Foundation Umpire Education Course

- Hold a current QLD Netball Membership
- Purchase a whistle (note: metal hand held whistle preferred)
- Purchase a current netball rule book
- Ensure you have a white top and skirt to wear when umpiring



The payment system for 2018 will be as follows:

Learner Umpires	\$0 per game	Umpires with an umpire coach, wears a yellow learner vest
Intermediate / Non-Badged Umpires	\$5 per game	Umpires with minimal supervision, wears a light blue vest
NGCNA Silver Badge Umpires	\$10 per game	Umpires with no supervision
National "C" Badge Umpires	\$15 per game	
National "B" Badge Umpires	\$20 per game	
National "A" Badge Umpires	\$30 per game	
Club / Rep Carnival Days	\$60 - \$100 per day
