

Approved PAPRC Range Firearm Calibres and Shooting Activities (2019)

The RCMP Chief Firearms Officer recently renewed the approvals for certain calibers and shooting activities at the club's west (Buckland) Shooting Range.

This approval is subject to the following conditions:

- The rental agency must follow the same rules as the club.*
- The type of firearms used must be approved for discharge.*
- Fully automatic firearms are not allowed.*
- The type of shooting activity must be approved.*
- The rental agency must keep a record of all range users.*

The Prince Albert Pistol and Rifle Club's **Silhouette** Range is approved for:

- Standing and bench rest static line shooting only.*
- All handgun cartridges contained in the CFO's template groups ".22 long rifle:", "9mm Parabellum" and ".357 S&W Magnum"*
- All rifle cartridges contained in the CFO template groups ".22 long rifle", ".223 Remington", ".308 Winchester", and ".338 Lapua Magnum".*
- Shotgun shooting is not approved.*
- This range is approved for reactive target type shooting (steel plates, etc.) but all splatter must be captured by backstops. Reactive targets must not be closer than 10 meters from the firing point.*
- All shooting activities will take place from the firing line.*
- Explosive targets are not allowed.*

The Prince Albert Pistol and Rifle Club's **Multi-Purpose** Range is approved for:

- Standing and bench rest static line shooting only*
- All handgun cartridges contained in the CFO's template groups ".22 long rifle:", "9mm Parabellum" and ".357 S&W Magnum".*
- All rifle cartridges contained in the CFO template groups ".22 long rifle", ".223 Remington", ".308 Winchester", and ".338 Lapua Magnum".*
- Shotgun shooting is approved for lead or steel shot sizes (including rifled or sabot slugs) without restrictions.*
- This range is approved for reactive target type shooting (steel plates, etc.) but all splatter must be captured by backstops. Reactive targets must not be closer than 10 meters from the firing point.*
- All shooting activities will take place from the firing line.*
- Explosive targets are not allowed.*
