NORTHWOOD – The Worth County Board of Supervisors, in conjunction with County Officials, decided County Offices will be closed to the public, effective Tuesday, March 17, 2020, until further notice. This change is due to the national emergency regarding the COVID-19.

Limited public access to the Courthouse building will still be available through the Sheriff's Office. Clerk of Court will still be open at this time. The Board encourages the public to come to County facilities for essential purposes only. They also encourage calling ahead to determine if an in person visit is necessary or not.

The Treasurer's office requests citizens use their drop box to conduct business when possible.

If you are filing papers for the June 2 Primary Election, please call 641-324-2316, Option 2, and the Auditor's Office will provide directions to you in order to receive the paperwork for the March 20, 2020 and March 25, 2020 deadlines.
