#### **Tennis & Pickleball**

#### **Pool Notes and Reminders**

There are several items we need you to review and share with your household. As we cannot anticipate every action or behavior at our facility to compile a lengthy list of pool rules and guidelines, please follow the direction of our lifeguards and pool management company. Questioning or ignoring directions from the lifeguards will not be tolerated. If you experience an issue, please go to the Pool Office and ask for the Pool Manager on duty. Please note that you may have to wait if the manager is on rotation. Do not distract the lifeguards in the stands unless there is a life-threatening emergency.

Here are some reminders due to recent violations:

- No children may be in the kiddie pool area without a supervising parent/guardian.
- The kiddie pool is for children five years old and younger.
- Feet first in a seated position on the slide.
- One person at a time on the diving board, stairs, or slide at a time.
- No talking or distracting the lifeguards in the stand unless there is a life-threatening situation.
- Follow the directions of the guards and ask questions to the Pool Manager or submit a feedback form\* to the Board
- No glass may be brought onto the pool deck.
- Disrespectful, hateful, or vulgar language or gestures will not be tolerated.

Please note patrons may be asked to leave for the day and may be suspended from using the facility for violating the rules. Also, please remind your children with approved, unsupervised access that coming to the pool without direct parent/guardian supervision is a privilege and can be revoked for violating the pool rules.

**Food Deliveries:** Make sure you specify **1508A – Pool** (not the house at 1508 Sadlers Wells) when ordering food for delivery. Also, it is your responsibility to watch for the delivery vehicle. The lifeguards are not responsible for announcing deliveries.

**Hours:** The pool is open daily 11 am–9 pm. Watch for communications for adjusted hours due to holidays, swim meets, etc.

**Complaints/Feedback:** Forms are available near the entry door and can be placed in the clubhouse front door mail slot or emailed to hiddenbrook homes@hotmail.com.


