In August, Advanced Drama students from Templeton High School will travel to Edinburgh, Scotland to perform in the world famous "FRINGE Festival".

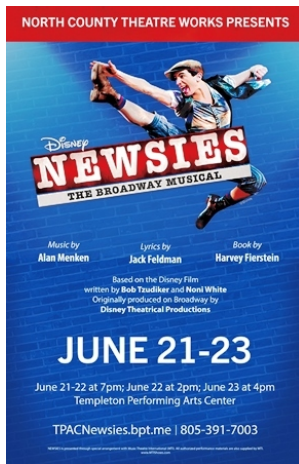

North County Theatre Works presents "Newsies" - a Disney musical based on the the real life newsboy strike



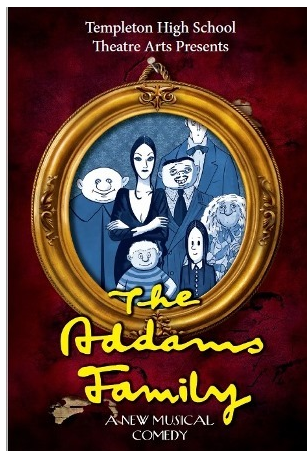




Templeton Unified School District (TUSD) is working on a plan to fill the superintendent position after its current superintendent - Joe Koski - notified the district of his resignation.

On May 24, Koski emailed a letter to the district and the community notifying them of his decision to not pursue a contract renewal beyond July 30 ([CLICK HERE](#) to read letter).

"20 Weeks to Prep"

The County Office of Emergency Services (OES) is launching a 20-week social media campaign this weekend, calling on residents to be better prepared for a disaster.

The campaign, "20-Weeks to Prep", will run Sundays beginning June 2 thru October 13 on the County OES **Facebook** and Twitter pages. Each week, County OES will post a list of disaster supplies to gather, along with tasks to complete for that week. The goal is to provide a step-by-step plan for residents to build an emergency kit that will be much needed during a disaster.

Using hashtag #SLO20W2P, residents will have an opportunity to share their progress as the weeks go by. County OES expects more management on social media platforms as a result of the campaign, leading to more people receiving emergency information during an incident.
