

**Ashburn City Council Meeting**  
**Thursday, August 4<sup>th</sup>, 2016**

**Present: Mayor Pro-tem John Burgess, City Manager Sedric Carithers, Councilmembers Sandra Lumpkin, Howard Jordan, Tommy Bateman, James Burks, and City Attorney Tommy Coleman**

**City Manager Sedric Carithers informed the council on the new road that will be built from Gorday to Cedar Drive and the cost would be around \$84,000 for sewer and water lines to be installed. Flash Foods wants the TCDA to pay \$69,000. The TCDA would like for the City to pay something on this project. The Council agreed to make a contribution on the project, but would not commit to an amount right now due to the three ongoing DOT Projects.**

**Motion was made by Councilmember Burks, second by Councilmember Lumpkin to adopt the Ordinance on Motorized Carts changing the insurance required from \$250,000 to \$25,000 and to dispense of the second reading. Ayes: Bateman, Burks, Lumpkin, Jordan**

**Motion was made by Councilmember Jordan, second by Councilmember Bateman for the City to sell Surplus parcels of land within the city. These parcels of land are not large enough to build on and border citizens property who would like to purchase it. Ayes: Bateman, Burks, Lumpkin, Jordan**

**After much discussion on the present contract for Probation Services, City Attorney Tommy Coleman will research further on the contract before the City makes a decision to change Probation Services.**
