  - Is the Area abiding by the recommendations as stipulated in the Procedure Manual?
  - How is the Area passing on the principles in the Traditions and Concepts?
- 3. When conducting the Assembly business, do you feel that there is adequate discussion of proposals and business items for there to be a clear and effective group conscience reached?
  - Is adequate opportunity given to all members to speak and participate in Assembly business and arrive at the actual voice and effective conscience for our whole Area?
  - Are proposals brought to the Assembly made clear so all know what they are voting for or against?
  - How well does the Area treat "Right of Appeal" (minority opinion)
- 4. Are service positions defined adequately in the the Procedures manual so that our area servants can be effective in their positions?
  - Do all Area servants have well defined scope of authority and service responsibility by specific job descriptions or guidelines?
  - Are Area servants picked with care and consideration?
- 5. Are we meeting our financial responsibilities?
  - *Is the Area self-supporting?*
  - Does the Area operate on a prudent financial principle with sufficient operating funds?
  - Does the Area have an effective system for accounting of funds and reporting back to the groups?
- 6. Is our membership a good reflection of our A.A. community and how well are we communicating with our membership?
  - What is the Area doing to communicate with its members throughout the Area?
  - Are adequate facilities and locations being chosen for Area Workshops and Assemblies?
  - Are we attracting a good cross section of A.A. members into area service?
