Jesus Changes Everything

A good man. A crazy person. A prophet. The son of God

You'll often get a strong response if you talk to others about Jesus. Some will tell you they already know Him; some may say they want nothing to do with what you're trying to say. Some might cry when hearing about Him; others may see it as an opportunity to debate. Jesus has been a polarizing figure in history. Mountains of opinions fill the landscape about who Jesus is and why He's worth talking about in the first place. Jesus' name may change the tone of a conversation, but His actions changed the world. The Gospel of Mark was most likely dictated to Mark by one of Jesus' disciples – Peter. Since Peter was a man of action, his account of Jesus' life is a fast-paced examination of the things Jesus did. As we look in the opening chapters of the Gospel of Mark, we will arrive an incredible conclusion: **JESUS CHANGES EVERYTHING!**
