## Recognition

Leo Brasil was 4 years old when he first entered his first 1K children's run. With cargo shorts and Crocs shoes, he ended up running the entire 1K distance without stopping, and at the fastest speed he could get. He finished right next to 10 and 11 year old boys.

In March of 2015 Leo joined the [Texas Thunder Track Club](#) and started his formal training.

Leo's dedication to running was amazing, he won multiple races, including 800m, 1,500m, and Cross Country 2K.

At School, he won the Patsy Sommer Track Attack, for being the boy who ran more laps around the trail in PE during the entire year.

This summer, Leo participated in all local running events around Texas.

In June 2017, he participated in the District finals in Killeen, Texas where he braved the heat and qualified to San Antonio Regional Finals two weeks later.

In San Antonio, the top 14 boys under 8-years were competing to get one of the 6 spots to represent Texas in the Nationals, Junior Olympics.

Leo finished in 6<sup>th</sup> place and recorded a new PR of 5m42s, which was a new 1,500m record for a Texas Thunder Athlete under 8-yrs old.

Leo qualified to attend the Junior Olympics in Detroit, Michigan.

Leo had the 13<sup>th</sup> best time in the nation. He finished in 22<sup>nd</sup> place, but was truly amazed by the opportunity to participate. He came back reignited and ready to train harder for the Cross Country season.



## INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY

- Please be sure to monitor the weather as well so that you can make travel decisions that best suit your family's needs

### **Carpool Policy for Inclement Weather:**

- We are happy to offer a carpool/drop-off staff assistance each morning between 7:45 a.m. and 8:15 a.m. for your convenience. However, for health and safety reasons, we will not have carpool when experiencing inclement weather conditions. This includes lightening, thunder, heavy rain or other precipitation and very low temperatures (35 degrees or below). Our administration will assess the conditions and decide whether it's safe for the staff to remain outside for carpool assistance.
- If you do not see the cones in the driveway or teachers on the curb, please park your car and walk your child to the lobby door. PLEASE use extra caution when parking and when leaving, as many parents and children will be crossing the parking lot during this busy time. Additionally, please help us limit the amount of traffic by parking your car instead of pulling up to the curb to drop your child in front of the door. When pulling into the driveway, please wait behind the cars ahead of you instead of bypassing them.
